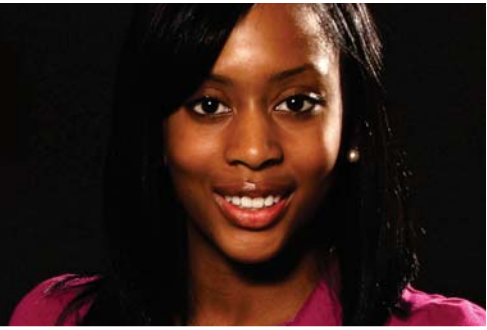

What you need to know about Census 2010 ...

It's so easy.

The 2010 census form asks you a few simple questions about members of your household – name, gender, age, race/ethnicity, relationship to the householder, and whether you rent or own your home. That's it. Surprised? Just drop the completed form into a mailbox by April 1, 2010, which is Census Day.

It's totally confidential.

Don't be afraid to be counted even if you are not a documented resident. Census forms are completely confidential for 72 years and cannot be shared with anyone, including welfare and immigration agencies, any court of law, and even the president of the United States. To protect your rights, there are harsh penalties for anyone who discloses information that can identify a respondent.

It helps fund community services.

Governments use census data to allocate funding for education, public safety, housing, roads, public transportation and other community services. Census data also determine representation in the federal and state legislatures and help attract businesses and jobs to our community.
