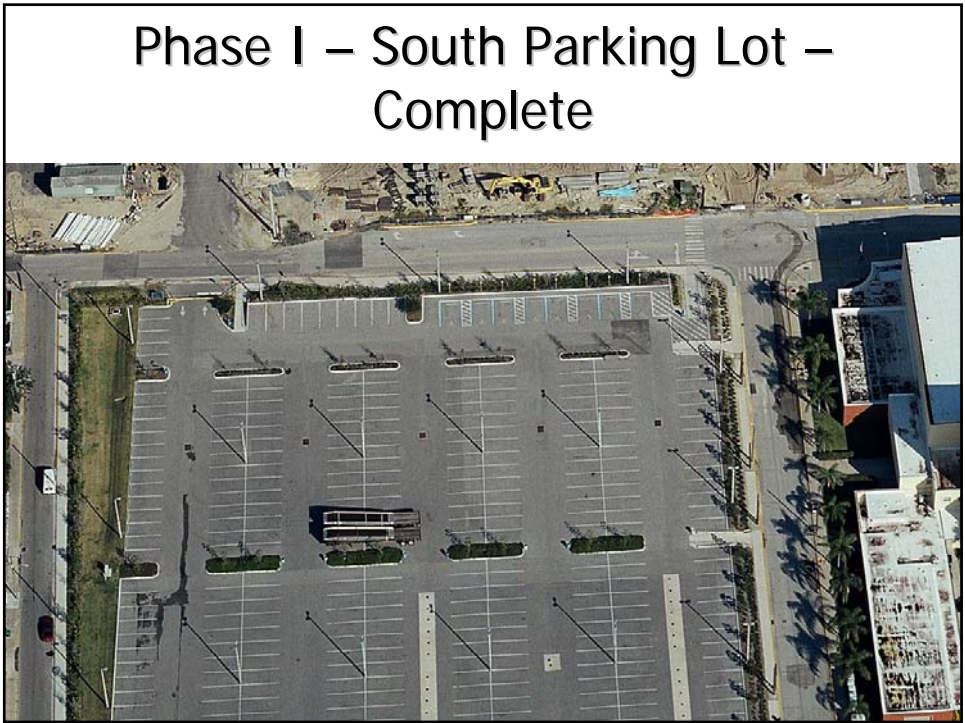
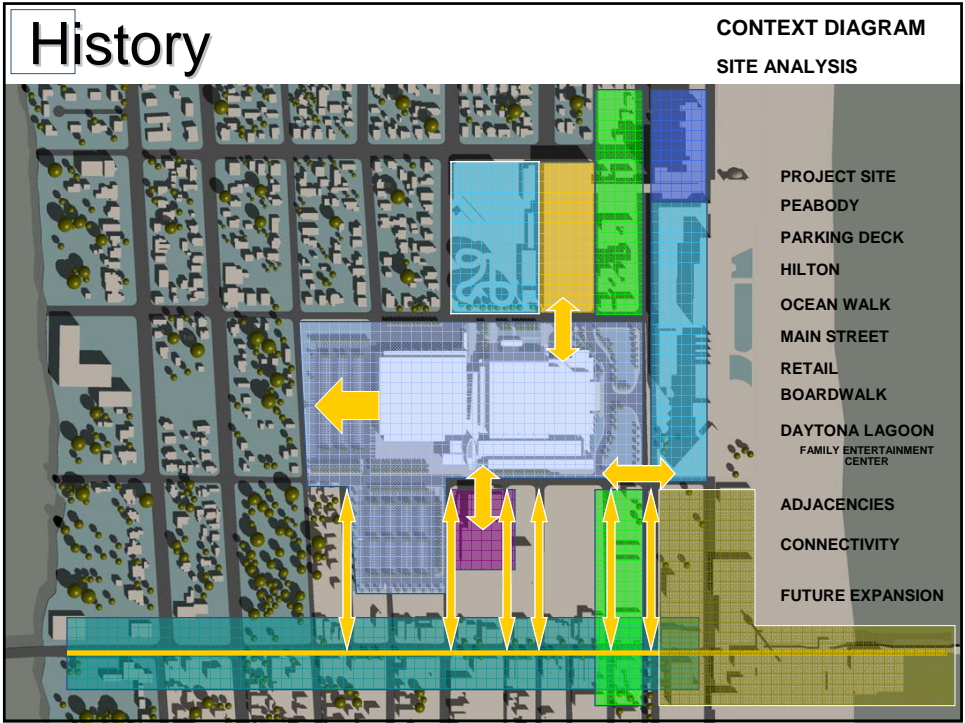

 - Completed February 2009
 - \$76 million

Construction facts...

- 67,000 square feet of glass and metal wall panels
- 60 million pounds of concrete
- 2.2 million pounds of reinforcing steel within the concrete

Construction facts...

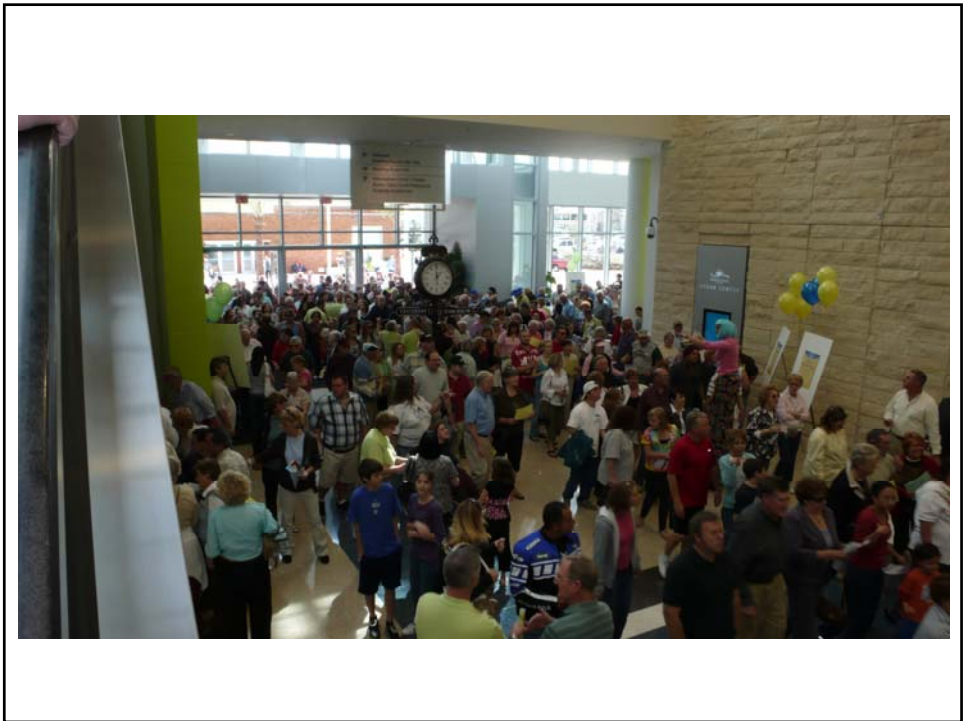
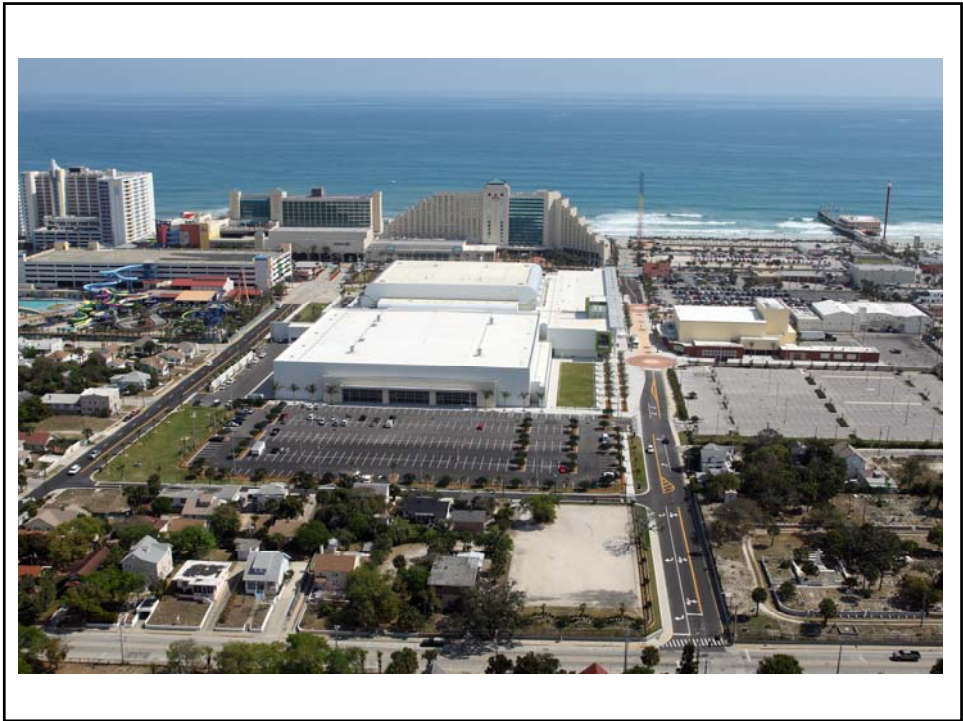
- 3.1 million pounds of structural steel
- 56,000 bolts to connect structural steel together

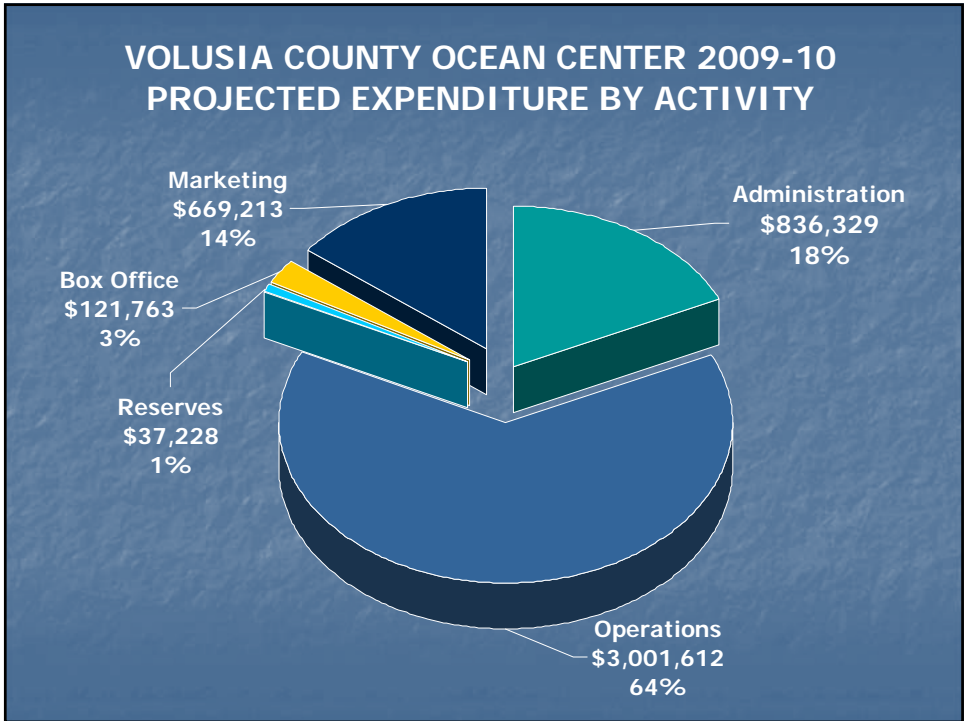
Construction facts...

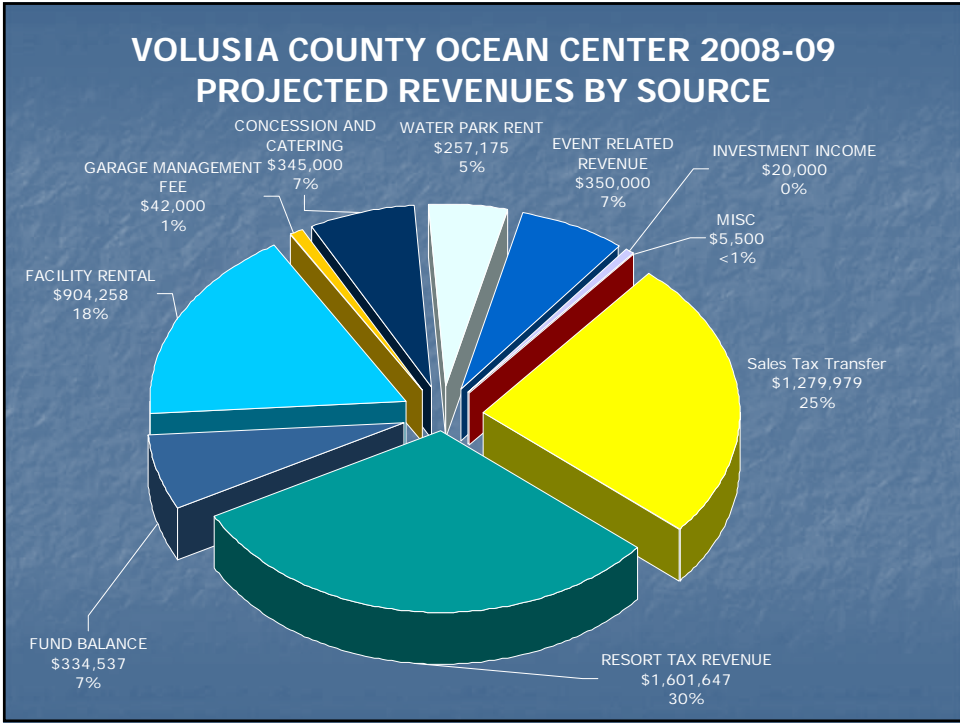
- 3 miles of irrigation pipe

 - Completed January 2009

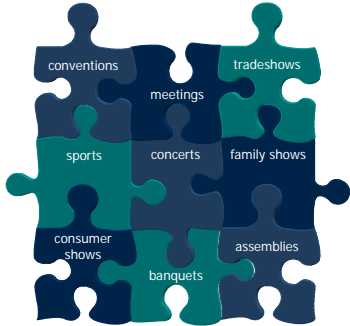
