Members of the Volusia County Fire Services Communications Team work inside the 40-foot mobile command and communications trailer and respond during large operations and special details. Using sophisticated communications equipment, the team receives critical information from department personnel, law enforcement, government agencies and the news media during an emergency response and communicates this vital information efficiently and accurately to those in charge of an incident.

Team members receive training in communications, CPR and basic Incident Command System and meet weekly to keep their skills current. A commercial drivers license is helpful, but not required. No experience is necessary so contact Volusia County Fire Services today and become a valued member of the team.
