MAJOR FUNCTION

Semi-skilled manual labor in the performance of light and heavy manual laboring tasks in a wide variety of construction and maintenance work.

ILLUSTRATIVE DUTIES

(NOTE: These are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work performed. The omission of specific duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position.)

Performs examples of work at the lower levels.

Operates power mowers, chain saws, brush cutter, edger and clippers, and other equipment used in landscaping, roadside maintenance, and right of way cleaning.

Operates tractor in landscaping projects and on roadsides.

Operates trucks and other light equipment.

Assists dragline operators in laying out work and in maintenance of machines.

Assists repair technicians and journeyman in duties.

Assists in brick laying, pipe laying, painting, carpentry, plumbing, electrical work, roofing and other construction tasks.

May serve as a lead worker on a small work crew.

Performs related work as required.

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS

All knowledge, abilities and skills of lower levels of Maintenance Workers.

Knowledge of light equipment used in maintenance, grounds keeping, and construction.

Knowledge of occupational hazards and necessary safety precautions applicable to safe operation of this equipment.

(Maintenance Worker III- continued)

Ability to operate light trucks, small tractors, mowers and similar automotive equipment.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

One (1) year of experience as a Maintenance Worker II with Volusia County. Possession of a valid Class B Commercial Driver's License (CDL) or Florida driver license may be required, depending on location of position.

A comparable amount of education, training, or experience may be substituted for the minimum qualifications.

ADA REQUIREMENTS

ADA requirements may vary depending on division of assignment.

Physical Demands: Medium to heavy work. Ability to see, talk. Ability to lift (weight requirement determined by division of assignment), grasp, push, pull, handle, reach overhead, balance, climb. Ability to traverse uneven, wet or broken terrains.

Environmental Demands: Generally outside work. Ability to tolerate inclement weather including heat, humidity, cold. May require exposure to chemicals, dust, insects, fumes, noise, confined space.

Mental Demands: Ability to read and comprehend safety instructions, procedures, memos, and directions. Ability to write simple sentences relaying information. Ability to perform basic math such as addition and subtraction.
