

## Tomoka Landfill and West Volusia Transfer Station

Household garbage, yard trash, land clearing, construction debris, appliances and tires are accepted for a nominal fee at the Tomoka Landfill and West Volusia Transfer Station. Yard waste must be separated.

County residents may dispose of up to four regular passenger car size tires free on Saturdays and Sundays.

Used motor oil may not be disposed of in the landfill. A noncommercial used oil recycling igloo is available on site.
