Recycling with the two-bin system



Recycling is our future

Two-bin recycling system

Volusia County's Solid Waste Division distributes two recycling bins to each household in unincorporated areas.

Two bins enhance our recycling program by adding more materials and improving the quality of what is recycled.



Please use one bin for paper materials including:

- Newspaper and inserts
- Phone books, junk mail and magazines
- Mixed residential paper
- Cardboard, including corrugated, cereal and pizza boxes, drink and snack boxes.

Helpful hints

Fold large cardboard boxes to 4 feet by 4 feet.

Do not tie or bundle flattened cardboard boxes.

Remove liners from food boxes.

The second bin may be used for:

- Aluminum and steel cans
- Glass bottles
- Plastics coded 1 - 7



Helpful hints

Remove caps from plastic and glass bottles and place the bottles in bin.

Rinse plastic containers that may have held toxic or contaminated material before placing them in the recycle bin.

Rinse cans and jars to reduce odor and discourage pests, such as ants, from invading your bin.

No Styrofoam or plastic bags, please!

Single-bin system

If you have only one recycling bin, please place your bottles and containers in the bottom of the bin. Put paper materials in a paper grocery bag and place the bag on top of the other items.
