

**NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY
NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION PROGRAM (NSP)
PERMANENT RENTAL HOUSING**

This notice announces the availability of funds under the Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP) for activities to provide permanent rental housing for persons with very-low income and/or homeless persons.

Funding in the approximate amount of \$600,000 is available from the County of Volusia through funding provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the Neighborhood Stabilization Program. The Community Assistance Division is soliciting partner organizations to acquire, rehabilitate and provide long-term rental management of NSP rental housing as an NSP subrecipient. Agencies must be a non-profit organization and a member of the Volusia/Flagler County Coalition for the Homeless Continuum of Care and/or a locally certified Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO). The organization must provide documentation of capacity and history of property management serving very-low income and/or homeless households.
