- Community Assistance provides assistance to indigent and needy residents. Staff coordinates the various programs funded by federal, state and local agencies for more efficient use and delivery of community resources.
- Cooperative Extension Service is a partnership between the University of Florida and Volusia County Government to provide educational programming related to natural resources, livestock, commercial horticulture, urban horticulture, 4-H programs and family and consumer counseling.
- Library Services collects, organizes and provides a quality selection of books and other materials and programs to residents and visitors.

- Parks, Recreation and Culture provides recreation programs, parks and other facilities that embrace Environmental, Cultural, Heritage and Outdoor (ECHO) activities and sites.




- Volusia County Health Department is a state agency whose
