- Permit application must include name and license number of subcontractors; complete jobsite address which includes building address, street name, city and parcel number. Applications in <u>pencil</u> will not be accepted. Addresses can be obtained from Volusia County Mapping Department (386-736-5959), and the Property Appraiser's office (386-736-5901) can assist you with obtaining the correct parcel number
- ❖ Notice of Commencement a certified copy of the recorded Notice of Commencement is required for any job greater than \$2500.00, and is to be submitted to this office prior to the first inspection. (The Notice of Commencement is not required at time of submittal). The Notice of Commencement must be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court
- ❖ Zoning Site Plan Show to scale, existing & proposed site improvements, with location of well & septic, if applicable
- ❖ Energy Forms must have complete jobsite address, signed & dated
- Crown of the Road Variance Application Site plans are to show existing & proposed elevations & drainage patterns
- ❖ Driveway Site Plans Show driveway & apron dimensions
- ❖ Construction Plans Are required to be a minimum scale of ¼" = 1', showing all proposed construction to include: floor plans, foundation plan, all four elevation views, structural wall sections of house, covered patios, decks and fireplace details. All construction plans must comply with the current Florida Building Code, section R301 signed, sealed & dated by a Florida registered Architect or Engineer. In addition, the plans must contain roof assembly information including substrate, type of roofing system, materials, fastening requirements, flashing requirements, wind rating, product evaluation or site specific statement by a Florida registered Architect or Engineer

<u>Note:</u> All fees shall be adjusted annually on October 1, based upon the percentage change in the United States Department of Commerce Consumer Price Index for the twelve-month period ending on June 30 of that year. The next adjustment of fees will be <u>Oct 1, 2018.</u>
