This notice is intended to provide citizens with reasonable notice and opportunity to comment on proposed changes to the County of Volusia's Neighborhood Stabilization Program 3 Substantial Amendment Action Plan. The County of Volusia has reviewed the criteria for determining substantial change in approved Consolidated Plan activities in accordance with 24 CFR 91.505 and the Citizens Participation Plan.

This amendment modifies the NSP3 Action Plan budget by transferring budgeted funds into an activity for Volusia County to acquire, rehabilitate and resale foreclosed homes to low-income households (50% or less of the area median income).

NOTICE UNDER THE AMERICANS
