What do I need to do to take the Limited Commercial Landscape Maintenance exam?

- An original, signed Record of Attendance showing six hours of approved classroom training
- An exam fee of \$150.00 (check or money order) made out to "DACS"
- Completed application form (see above link)
- Certificate of insurance (see above link)
- You may call the Bureau of Entomology at (850) 617-7997 to have an application sent to you.

NOTE: You do not have to take the exam the day of the class. If more time is needed to prepare, keep all your documents above together. Make an appointment, by calling the Extension office (386) 822-5778, within __ months to take the exam.
