

ORDINANCE 2014-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE COUNTY OF VOLUSIA; AMENDING CHAPTER 10, AMUSEMENTS AND ENTERTAINMENTS, ARTICLE II, OUTDOOR ENTERTAINMENT EVENTS, TO PROVIDE FOR EXEMPTIONS FOR PROPERTY SUBJECT TO INTERLOCAL SERVICE BOUNDARY AGREEMENTS; AMENDING CHAPTER 26, BUSINESSES, ARTICLE III, ITINERANT MERCHANTS, TO PROVIDE FOR PERMITTED LOCATIONS IN COUNTY COMMERCIAL OR INDUSTRIAL ZONING CLASSIFICATIONS; PROVIDING FOR CONTINUING EFFECT; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION I:** Chapter 10, Amusements and Entertainments, Article II, Outdoor Entertainment Events, of the Code of Ordinances of the County of Volusia, is hereby amended as follows:

**Sec. 10-35. Exemptions; notice to sheriff of amplified sound.**

...



1 Said vacant lot may be utilized for parking during the periods authorized  
2 under this article, provided that vehicular access complies with the  
3 requirements of the Code.

5 **SECTION III:** CONTINUING EFFECT - Except as amended herein,  
6 the provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the County of Volusia remain in full  
7 force and effect.

8 **SECTION IV:** AUTHORIZING INCLUSION IN CODE - The  
9 provisions of this ordinance shall be included and incorporated into the Code of  
10 Ordinances of the County of Volusia, as additions or amendments thereto, and  
11 shall be appropriately renumbered to conform to the uniform numbering system  
12 of the code.

13 **SECTION V:** SEVERABILITY - Should any word, phrase, sentence,  
14 subsection or section be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal,  
15 void, unenforceable, or unconstitutional, then that word, phrase, sentence,  
16 subsection or section so held shall be severed from this ordinance and all other  
17 words, phrases, sentences, subsections, or sections shall remain in full force and  
18 effect.

19 **SECTION VI:** CONFLICTING ORDINANCES - All ordinances, or  
20 parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, repealed.

21 **SECTION VII:** EFFECTIVE DATE - A certified copy of this  
22 ordinance shall be filed with the Department of State by the County Manager

1 within ten (10) days after enactment by the County Council. This ordinance shall  
2 take effect upon filing.

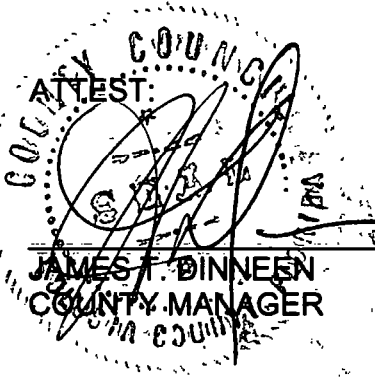
