- Tuition and salary pay during Corrections Officer Academy.
- Starting salary for a Corrections Officer Trainee is \$31,169. Upon becoming a certified Corrections Officer, the salary is \$34,489.
- Individual and family medical, dental, prescription, life, and vision insurance.
- Florida State Retirement, Special Risk — Earn 75% of salary at retirement. Special risk employees may retire after 30 years of service or reaching age 60 with full benefits.
- 204 hours of paid sick/vacation leave. Accruals start at hire, and accruals increase with longevity of service.

- Short- and long-term disability insurance.

### Hiring process

Applications can be filled out online at [www.volusia.org](http://www.volusia.org) or in any Volusia County public library. On the website, click on “career.”

Your application must be accompanied by scores from the Criminal Justice Basic Abilities Test for Corrections (CJ-BAT-COR) or verification of current FDLE certification. Contact the Daytona State College testing center at **386-506-3067** to arrange for testing. Test costs must be paid by the applicant, but will be reimbursed 30 days after the hire date.


#### Officer candidates undergo:

- Interview
- Physical abilities test (PAT)
- Background investigation, including criminal history, neighborhood and employment verification
- Polygraph or computerized voice stress analysis (CVSA)
- Drug and tobacco screening






## Volusia County. Daytona Beach.
