SELECTION OF VICE CHAIR

Motion to nominate Mayor Chris Cloudman as Vice Chair was made by Mayor Bill Partington and seconded by Mayor Fred Cleveland. Motion carried unanimously by voice vote.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES – JULY 17, 2023

Motion to approve the meeting minutes as presented was made by Mayor Bill Partington and seconded by Commissioner Stacy Cantu. Motion carried unanimously by voice vote.

REVIEW MISSION STATEMENT PREVIOUSLY DEVELOPED

The previously developed mission statement was *Augment and address current and future safety and capacity needs for Volusia transportation*. Chair Burnette asked if any members would like to change or clarify the statement. A consensus was made

to revise the previous statement to Identify, prioritize, and address current and future safety and capacity needs for Volusia transportation.

DISCUSSION ON OBJECTIVES AND STRATEGIES OF THIS SUBCOMMITTEE

Discussion ensued between subcommittee members and Volusia County Public Works Director, Ben Bartlett, to determine projects to focus on. Subcommittee members were concerned if they would interfere with the county and state projects. Mr. Bartlett suggested advocating for projects already in place but at different phases.

The members would like to identify three top east side and west side projects/needs and future projects and utilize Volusia League of Cities advocacy. Some potential future projects considered for the west side included Saxon Boulevard widening (from five lanes to six lanes to from Finland Drive to Normandy Boulevard) and Kepler Road widening (from two lanes to four lanes State Road 44 to Minnesota Avenue). Mr. Bartlett interjected that the County is holding off on the Kepler Road project section of the roundabout until it is built. He mentioned another west side project would be the Rhode Island extension over I-4.

Chair Burnette suggested that Mr. Bartlett bring back a list of three or more projects that the subcommittee can advocate toward. Mr. Bartlett agreed and will also update the subcommittee on the stages each project is in and funding status.
