Value of construction for permits will be determined by the most recent publishing of the International Code Council estimates per square foot, including the regional modifier, of all areas under roof according to the type of construction and use.

III. PLAN REVIEW FEES (Non-refundable)

When the valuation of proposed construction exceeds \$5,000.00 a plan review fee shall be paid to the Building Activity at the time of issuing the building permit. This fee shall cover the cost of reviewing plans for code compliance and preparing marked documents. Plan review fees will not be charged on permits issued using master plans or plans reviewed by a Private Provider service as described in FS 553. The amount of the plan review fee shall be as follows:

All of the fees in Resolution 2005-191 (with the exception of licensing fees) shall be adjusted annually on October 1, based upon the percentage changes in the United States Department of Commerce CPI for the twelve month period ending on June 30 of that year. Revised October 1, 2016, to reflect +.01 increase in the CPI.

Inspection fees will be credited to all residential permits at a rate of \$26.95 per required inspection. The number of inspections on commercial permits will have to be estimated on a permit by permit basis and credited at \$26.95 per inspection.

ELECTRICAL PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE

PERMIT & INSPECTION FEES:

- I. BUILDINGS: All Electrical Permits - Minimum Fee \$43.54
(Includes all electrical wiring or fixture installations)

- II. Fees for installation of new electrical service and increases to existing electrical service shall be figured on the ampere increase in service based on the following fee schedule.
 - Single Phase Services Fee - per ampere increase \$0.56
 - Three Phase up to 240 volt fee - per ampere increase \$0.71
 - Three Phase over 240 volt fee per ampere increase \$1.42

 - Alterations and/or rewiring of existing systems per circuit for the first ten (10) circuits altered or added \$7.24
 - AND for each addition circuit \$1.42
 - Fees for ampere increases shall control over fees for circuit increases.

Appeals for the Building Trades Board will only be accepted by the Contractor Licensing office if the application is received or postmarked on or before September 30th of the 2nd year following the year the competency card went delinquent.

¹ Registered Contractors

Registration renewals pertain to those that were grandfathered-in, in regards to Ord. #80-5, Ord. #80-6 & Ord. #81-35, and those contractors accepted per inter-local agreements with cities within Volusia County.

² Certified Contractors

- The \$90.00 biennial Listing fee for certified contractors is a voluntary fee and may be renewed annually for \$45.00 if requested by the contractor.
- Certified contractors may decline participation in the Volusia County Contractor Licensing Program. Proof of licensure and insurance will be required for each permit application. This also applies to contractors working in cities that have elected by inter-local agreements to allow Volusia County to handle their contractors licensing program.

³ Local Specialty Contractors

Local Specialty Contractors will be issued a Competency Card. There is no State registration to obtain. All requirements for liability insurance and worker's compensation apply to Local Specialty Contractors.

Certified and Registered Contractors must furnish proof of public liability insurance per Rule 61G4-15.003 Florida Administrative Code. Electrical Contractors and Master Electricians must furnish proof of insurance per Rule 61G6-5.008 Florida Administrative Code. All Contractors must furnish proof of Worker's compensation per Chapter 440 Florida Statutes.

No building permits will be issued until insurance requirements are satisfied.

Stop work orders may be issued during construction if insurance coverage is terminated.

EXHIBIT "G"
VOLUSIA COUNTY
REFUNDS

Application and plan review fees are not refundable. No refund will be granted on any permit with a fee of less than \$100.00. For permits having a fee in excess of \$100.00, 70% of the amount above \$100.00 may be refunded, provided construction has not commenced. A letter requesting a refund stating the reason and with the original permit placard attached must be submitted. Letters requesting refunds must be received by the Building and Zoning Division within ninety days of the permit's date of issuance.

EXHIBIT "H"
VOLUSIA COUNTY
PERMITS TO COMPLETE PROJECTS

To complete a project for which the original permit has been canceled or expired, a new building permit for the same project shall be required. Fees for the new permit shall be assessed based on a percentage of the original building permit fees paid. The amount of the new fee will be determined by using the schedule below:

<u>Construction Stage</u>	<u>Percentage Assessment of Original Fee Paid</u>
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If the first inspection was not made and approved, fee for new permit shall be based on current fee schedule.

Plumbing and Foundation Inspection approved and concrete slab poured.....	60%
Lintel inspection approved for masonry construction	50%
Framing inspection approved	40%
Final inspection only	20%
Plus any outstanding fees from original permit	
Minimum fee for a permit to complete	\$43.54

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EXHIBIT "I"
VOLUSIA COUNTY
SINGLE BUILDING PERMIT SYSTEM

There shall be one (1) building permit issued to the contractor/builder of record, which shall be deemed the permits for the trade work and secondary work types.

1. The permit applicant will be required, at the time of making application, to list all major subcontractors along with each subcontractor's certification or registration number they intend to use for the work. The list shall include, but not be limited to, the electrical, plumbing, mechanical, roofing, alarm, fire sprinkler, gas, specialty structural and solar contractors.
2. When a change in subcontractors named on the original building permit is made, it is the responsibility of the permit applicant to notify Volusia County Building Activity and submit change of contractor post card(s) with all pertinent information relative to the new subcontractor (with postage). Inspections will be suspended until a new subcontractor is assigned.

EXHIBIT "J"
VOLUSIA COUNTY

Applicants applying for permits on construction or work started, without a permit for which a permit is required, will be charged a double permit fee for the first occurrence. For the second or any subsequent occurrences, a \$290.35 additional penalty plus the double permit fee will be charged and a complaint filed with the Department of Business and Professional Regulation in the case of certified contractors, or the appropriate Volusia County Board in the case of registered contractors.

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
