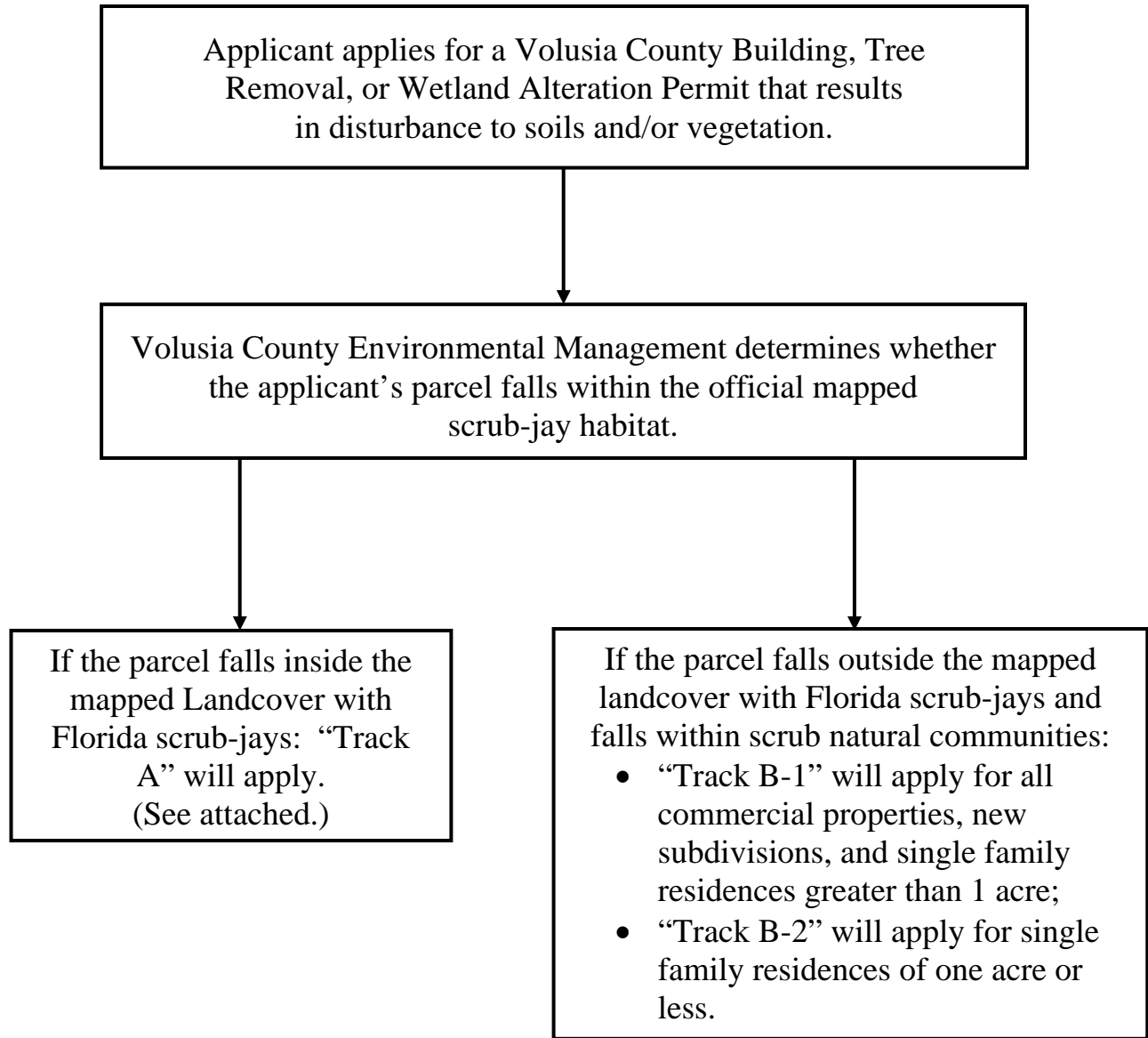


Volusia County Protocol for Building, Tree Removal, and Wetland Alteration Permits on Parcels of Property that May Contain Scrub Jays.\*

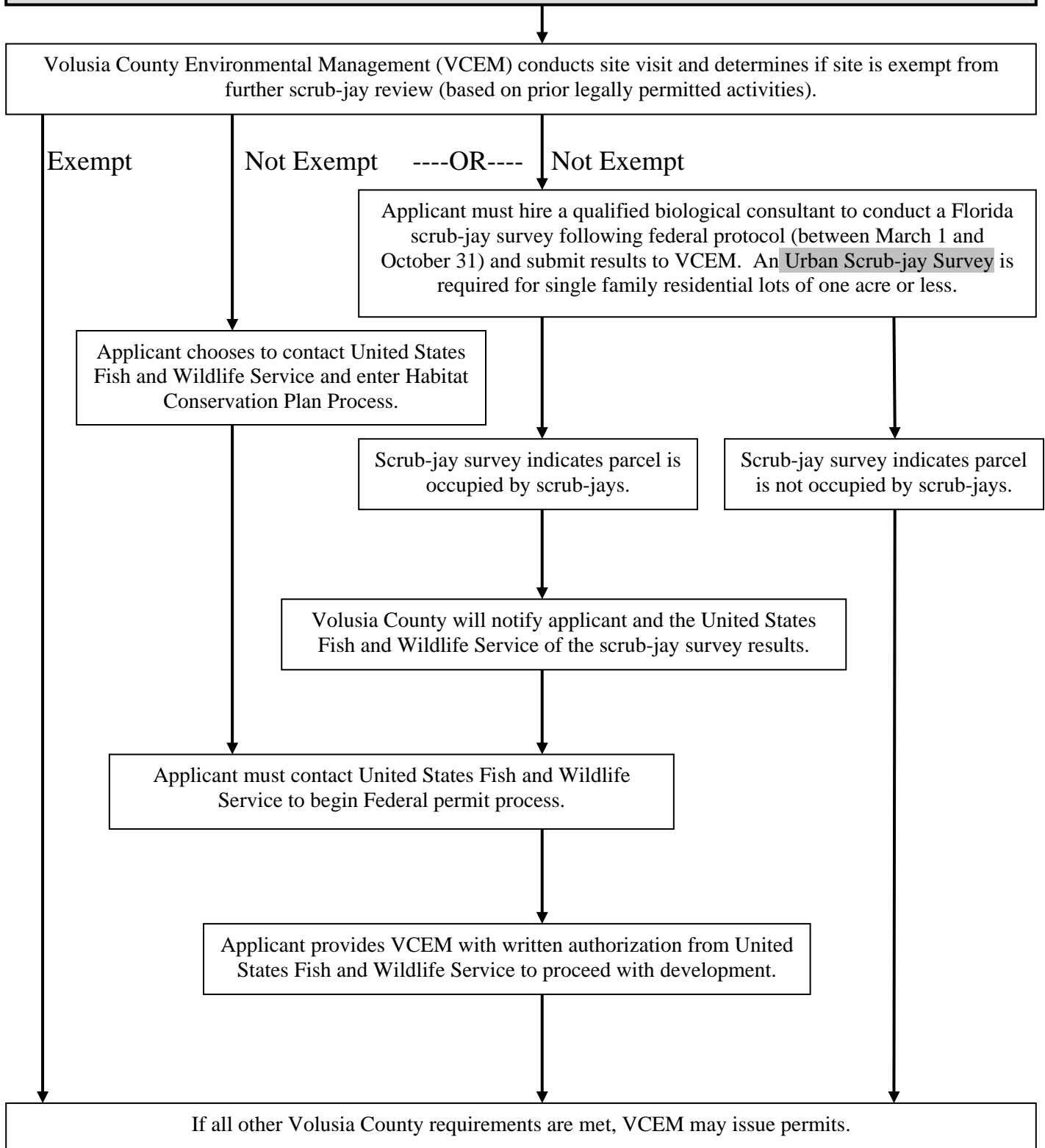

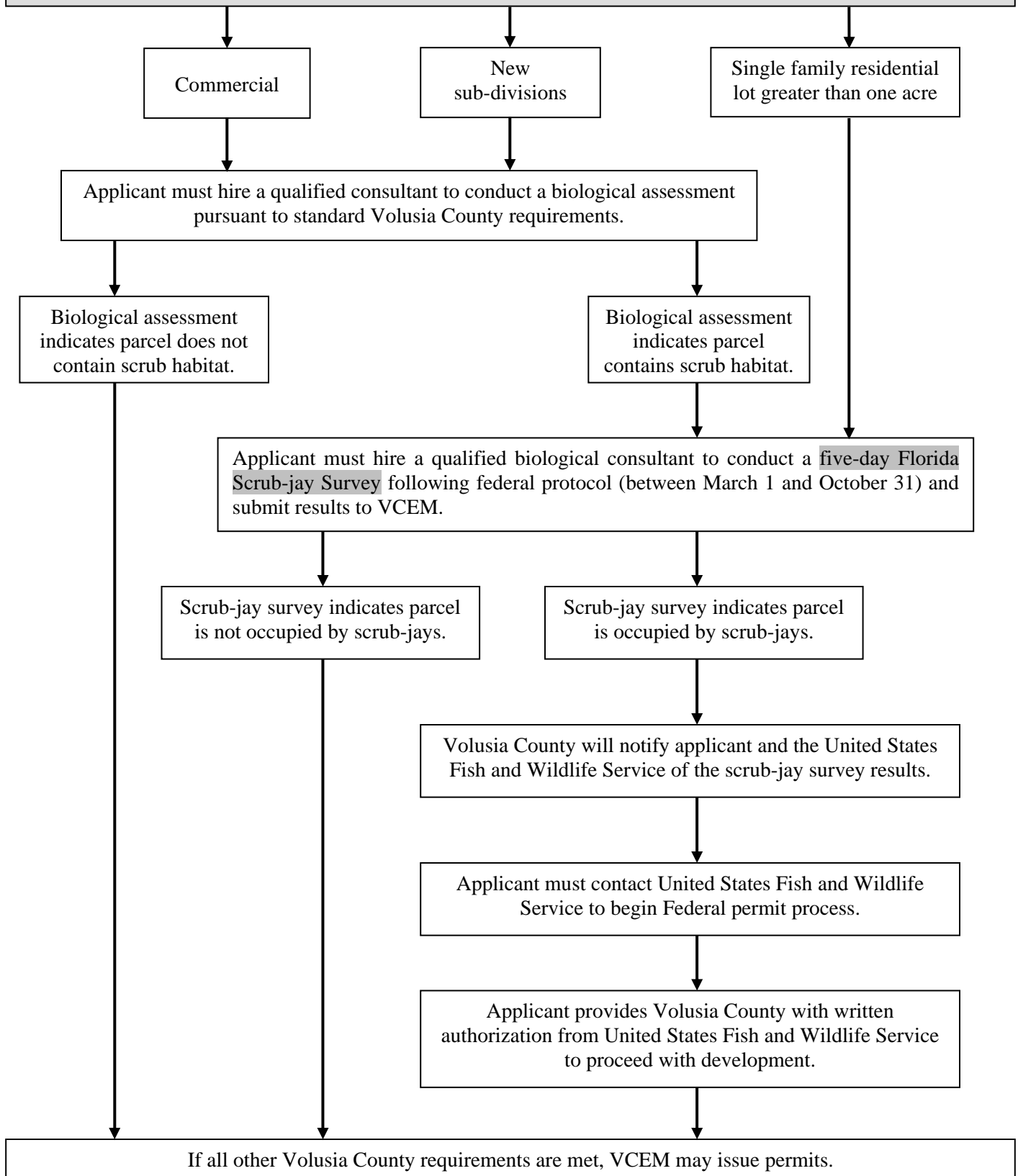

This protocol will apply to all parcels that require Volusia County Environmental Management (VCEM) review.

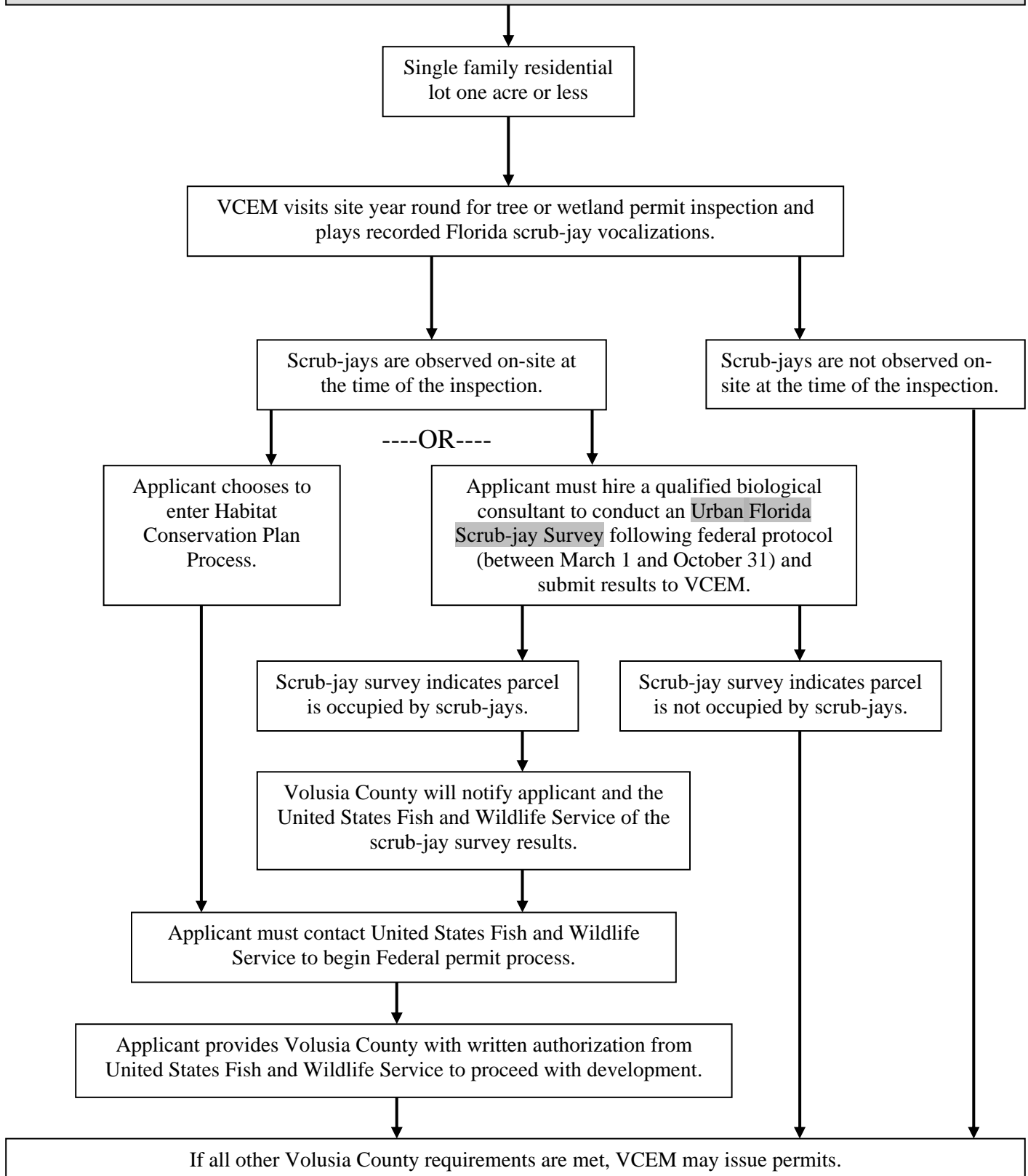
