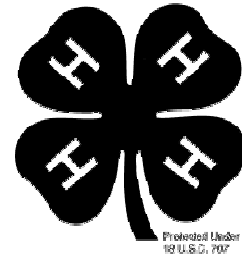


Volusia County 4-H
