



4-H Club Scrapbook Contest Guidelines Entries due July 1, 2008



Include a sheet inside the cover of the scrapbook with the club's name, type of club (project club or community club), number of members, age range of members and a paragraph (50 words or less) describing your club's activities and goals.

Scrapbooks can be created in a binder, an official "scrapbook," or any other creative method upon which the club decides.

1. EFFECTIVE TITLES AND CAPTIONS.....	10
A. Short, catchy, appropriate and well placed	
B. Well worded to cover subject matter	
C. Suggest action when appropriate	
2. DRAWS ATTENTION.....	15
A. With something unusual such as clever design, color use or special features or embellishments	
B. Decorations reinforce but do not withhold attention from main idea, uncluttered	
3. JOURNALING THAT DEMONSTRATES CREATIVE WRITING SKILLS.....	20
A. Includes dates, names of participants, type of activities, reasons for the club's involvement	
B. Brief descriptions of what the club learned while participating in the year's activities, how problems were handled and what made those experiences memorable	
4. AGE APPROPRIATE.....	20
A. Craftsmanship and topics chosen should reflect the efforts and activities of 4-H club members	
5. PLEASING APPEARANCE.....	10
A. The scrapbook is artistic, neat, attractive, and demonstrates effective use of color	
6. REFLECTS 4-H CLUB ACTIVITIES EFFECTIVELY.....	25
A. Material is brief and easily understood by the average person	
B. Size and number of charts, posters, lettering, etc., appropriate	
C. The scrapbook effectively portrays the club's 4-H experiences
