Walking on the dunes destroys the dunes and their essential vegetation. Access the beach only on walkovers.

Volusia County Code Enforcement



In an effort to keep the County of Volusia, safe, healthy and aesthetically pleasing to its residents, visitors, and business owners, Building and Zoning Code Compliance is tasked with enforcing County codes, the Florida Building Code and Florida statute 162 relating to a multitude of violations.

This brochure is a brief overview of the Volusia County Ordinances designed to protect the quality of life, improve economic vitality and protect the environment of Volusia County. Violations of the ordinance addressed in this brochure are ones most frequently called in to Building & Zoning Compliance.

LAWN AND LOT MAINTENANCE

Nuisance weeds and grass shall not exceed 12 inches.

No structure, shrub, or vegetation shall impede vision of traffic in all directions for driver of vehicles or cyclists.



BOATS - PARKING / STORAGE

Generally, boats must be stored behind all portions of the residence which face the street and must be stored at least five feet from the lot line.



TRACTOR - TRAILERS AND TRUCKS

No tractor-trailers, semi-trailer, commercial bus, cutaway van, chassis-cab or other trucks with a gross vehicle weight greater than 10,500 pounds, may be parked in any residential area except for loading and unloading.

VEHICLE PARKING



In residential areas, motor vehicles may not be parked anywhere in the front yard except on driveways. This also applies to vehicles for sale.



HOUSE NUMBERS

Placement of house numbers is to be on the front of the building or on a separate structure in front of the building in such a way as to be easily visible from the street. Numbers should be three inches or higher and of contrasting color with the immediate background to which they are affixed.

VEHICLE STORAGE

Any vehicle which lacks a current license plate or is inoperable may be stored only in a completely enclosed garage.



RECREATIONAL VEHICLE

PARKING /STORAGE

Recreational vehicles including motor homes may not be parked in the front yard and must be stored at least five feet from the side and rear lot lines.

WASTE MATERIALS AND TRASH

Rubbish, trash, garbage or other waste materials must be properly disposed of and not stored on the property. For trash complaints on private property call Building & Zoning Compliance at (386)736-5925. For trash complaints on the right-of-way call Solid Waste at (386)943-7889.



CONSTRUCTION

Permits are required for most construction. To report construction without permits call Building & Zoning Compliance (386) 736-5925

UNSAFE BUILDINGS

If a building is abandoned, opened and accessible to children and transients, it is considered a danger to the community and should be reported to Building & Zoning Compliance (386) 736-5925

GARAGE SALES



Garage sales may be held by homeowners only two times per year and such sales are limited to one week for each sale. Garage sale signs may only be placed on-site.

FENCES, SHEDS & OTHER CONSTRUCTION

Regulations stipulate height and location of fences. For details when applying for the required permit, and to inquire whether a permit is needed for other construction such as sheds, window/door replacement, plumbing etc. Contact the Permitting Department at (386)736-5929
