MAJOR FUNCTION

Skilled work in the operation of heavy motor drive equipment.

ILLUSTRATIVE DUTIES

(NOTE: These are intended only as illustrations of the various types of work performed. The omission of specific duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position.)

Operates crane or equivalent. Places and removes pipe.

Operates tractor equipped with front end loader and backhoe with bucket of a yard or more. Operates truck mounted pavement stripping machine.

Operates a power grader on construction and maintenance work. Operates a heavy duty gasoline or diesel road roller compacting material.

Operates a heavy bulldozer and maintains a sanitary fill dump. Directs truck drivers as to dumping locations. Operates a bulldozer in fill area.

Operates a lowboy. Transports equipment to and from construction site.

Occasionally may operate a simple flatbed or dump truck, or a variety of minor powered machinery and equipment. Participates generally in the laboring work of the crew as workload demands.

Operates front end loader. Loads fill, rock, slag, and other construction materials.

Performs daily safety inspections of assigned equipment prior to and after use. Performs routine service and maintenance.

Performs related work as required.

KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND SKILLS

Knowledge of the operation and safety precautions of the particular equipment to which assignment is made.

Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions. Skill in the operation of complex construction equipment.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Completion of eighth (8th) grade and three (3) years of experience in the operation and maintenance of heavy construction equipment. Possession of a valid Florida CDL of a class determined by the division/service center of assignment within 6 months of appointment.

A comparable amount of education, training, or experience may be substituted for the minimum qualifications.

ADA REQUIREMENTS

Physical Demands: Light work. Ability to push (arm and leg), pull, reach, climb, sit, see (near and far acuity, depth perception, field of vision,) turn (neck, body), handle.

Environmental Demands: (Demands may change depending on division/service center and equipment of assignment.) Outside work. Exposure to inclement weather (heat, humidity, cold, rain), fumes, odors, noise, vibration, dust, poor ventilation.

Mental Demands: Ability to read and comprehend operational and safety instructions, procedures, rules, policies, warnings, memos. Ability to write simple sentences relaying information, data, and details. Ability to perform basic math.
