

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-_____

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATED TO STORMWATER UTILITY FEES; PROVIDING THE DEFINITION OF EQUIVALENT RESIDENTIAL UNIT (ERU); PROVIDING THE AMOUNT OF THE STORMWATER UTILITY FEE; PROVIDING FOR THE STORMWATER ASSESSMENT RATE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 122, Article IV of the Code of Ordinance of the County of Volusia a stormwater utility was established for the unincorporated areas of Volusia County; and

WHEREAS, Section 122-154 of said Code provides the authority for the County Council to construct and finance stormwater management systems as a stormwater utility; and

WHEREAS, Section 122-157 of said Code provides that the amount of the stormwater utility fee shall be set and may be amended from time to time by resolution of the County Council; and

WHEREAS, Section 122-158 of said Code provides a method of calculation for stormwater fees. NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA IN OPEN MEETING DULY ASSEMBLED IN THE COUNTY COUNCIL CHAMBERS AT THE THOMAS C. KELLY ADMINISTRATION CENTER, 123 WEST INDIANA AVENUE, DELAND, FLORIDA, THIS 2nd DAY OF JUNE, 2005, A.D., AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: An Equivalent Residential Unit (ERU) shall be equal to 2,775 square feet of man-made impervious area.

SECTION II: Beginning October 1, 2005, the Stormwater Utility Fee is hereby set at a maximum of \$8.00 per month, per ERU, and the current rate is set at \$6.00 per month, per ERU, is hereby adopted.

SECTION III: The non-ad-valorem assessment for the Stormwater Utility Fee will remain at the rate of \$72.00/ERU/year, until amended by Resolution by the County Council.

SECTION IV: Resolution No. 96-171 is hereby repealed.

SECTION V: This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
