The 1988 Solid Waste Management Act required each county in Florida to reduce its solid waste disposal needs by 30 percent by the end of 1994. Volusia residents and businesses strive to exceed the waste reduction goal every year.



Recycle at home

Residents are asked to participate in curbside and dropoff recycling programs. Residents should contact their city or county waste service office to receive a recycling bin and instructions.

Recycling saves resources and holds down escalating waste management costs.



Recycle at your business

To meet the state's 30 percent goal, the Volusia County Council passed a mandatory commercial recycling ordinance in December, 1993. This ordinance requires all businesses and multi-family complexes in Volusia County to recycle.

Businesses and multifamily complexes may contract for recycling services or haul materials to a recycling center themselves. For more information please contact:

● Tomoka Farms Road Landfill ● 1990 Tomoka Farms Road, Daytona Beach

NO Used motor oil may not be disposed of in the landfill. A noncommercial used oil recycling igloo is on site.

YES Household garbage, yard trash, land clearing, construction debris, appliances, and tires are accepted separated from each other. County residents may dispose of up to four regular passenger car size tires FREE on Saturdays and Sundays. Yard waste must be separated from other material. Telephone (386) 947-2952 (Mon.-Fri.) and 239-6470 (Mon.-Sun.).

Saturday and Sunday, 8 a.m.-3 p.m.

NO Used oil may not be placed in your garbage containers. A noncommercial used oil recycling igloo is available at the Transfer Station.

YES Household garbage, commercial garbage, construction debris, yard waste (separated) and tires. County residents may dispose of up to four passenger size tires FREE on Saturdays.

Hours: Monday-Friday, 7 a.m.-5 p.m.;
Saturday 8 a.m.-3 p.m.; closed Sunday.

● Household Hazardous Waste Facility ● 1990 Tomoka Farms Road, Daytona Beach

Residents of Volusia County may bring small quantities of household hazardous waste materials such as cleaning fluids, solvents, motor oil, herbicides, pesticides and paint to the collection center.

Twice a year, usually spring and fall, Volusia County establishes dropoff sites throughout the county. Please call Volusia County Solid Waste for the next Household Hazardous Waste Amnesty Days.
