

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF OAK HILL, FLORIDA TO SUPPORT MAP "A" AS PRESENTED AND ACCEPTED BY THE VOLUSIA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS (VCOG) SMART GROWTH COMMITTEE AS ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE LANDS CONSERVED FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS.

Whereas, the City of Oak Hill believes in the conservation of environmentally sensitive lands within Volusia County; and

Whereas, City of Oak Hill also supports unique walkable communities, towns and cities in Volusia County; and

Whereas, the Volusia Council of Governments (VCOG) Smart Growth Committee has recommended conservation of lands designated within the final Map "A" areas; and

Whereas, the City of Oak Hill is a member of VCOG and is committed to the use of acceptable smart growth tools to conserve Map A lands that promote economic vitality and allow flexibility for each community's future; and

Now Therefore, be It Resolved at the regular meeting held on July 23, 2007 by the City of Oak Hill Commission of Oak Hill, Florida that the City of Oak Hill joins all Volusia communities, including the County of Volusia and the Volusia County School Board, in support of Map "A" in conserving

lands using agreed upon smart growth tools, and that this resolution become effective immediately upon its adoption.
