Summary/Highlights: Staff seeks approval for submission of the summer food service program grant application to the Florida Department of Education's Nutrition Management section and authorization to enter into the grant contract. This grant will enable the county to provide free, nutritionally-balanced meals to qualified children up to 18 years of age while schools are out for summer recess. The program will begin June 6, 2011 and end August 12, 2011. Approximately 269,652 meals and supplements will be served at 61 sites countywide.

Summary/Highlights Continued:

Service, Inc., St. Petersburg, Florida. On May 7, 2009, the county council accepted GA Food's bid submitted in response to ITB 09-B-65PW. The bid included the option to renew for four additional one-year terms. This would be the second renewal.

To manage the program effectively and efficiently, staff requests authority to hire 14 temporary workers: one full-time assistance coordinator, one full-time clerical assistant, six part-time monitors, and six part-time site supervisors. These temporary positions are only for the duration of the summer program. Community assistance division staff will oversee the programmatic and fiscal operation of the program. The grant will cover the entire cost of the meals and employment of the temporary staff.
