Beach Vehicular Access Fees

Six Different Fees

Daily access fees unchanged since 1993

**Season and Super Pass access fees
unchanged since 1995**

Fees collected from Feb. 1 through Nov. 30

Beach Vehicular Access Fees

Objectives

Simplify fee structure and accountability

Establish fee structure that offsets beach services cost related to vehicular access

Reduce cost burden to resident tax payers

Separate inlet park entry fees which are taxable by law

Beach Vehicular Access Fees

Simplified beach fees

\$10.00 **Daily pass**

\$25.00 **Resident annual pass**

Park fees

\$10.00 **Daily pass**

\$20.00 **Resident annual pass**

Beach Vehicular Access Fees

Projected net* revenue – beach access

\$2.6 million*

- gross revenue less collection commission and capital allocation

- comparative for FY 14 **\$1.3 million**
