



Transportation Trust Fund FY 11/12 Expense Budget






Declining Revenue






Transportation Funding Pie

New Construction




Bond Debt Service With Impact Fees

Impact Fee Allocation




Conclusion

This analysis has been unable to confirm any statistically significant relationship between impact fee reductions and higher rates of building permit issuance for single-family development. This finding will certainly not end the debate about the effects of impact fees on development activity, but hopefully it will inject some rationality into a discourse that up to now has been largely dominated by wishful thinking.

Transportation Impact Fee Considerations

- Current fee of \$2,173.88 has not been updated since 2003
 - Indexing stopped in 2007
- Council has always discounted the fee by never implementing the full recommended amount
 - 2007 recommendation was \$7,200.73
- Ordinance allows builders to pay impact fees at CO. Not an upfront cost
- Premise of \$65 mil bond program was to let growth pay the debt through impact fees
- Developers partnered with the County for road construction by the issuance of impact fee credits
- 2010 study concluded fee suspension does not stimulate construction
- Further reduction in fee revenues will have some effect on road program, O & M activities and local civil contractors. Other transportation revenue sources will be diverted to bond debt
- Glut of existing housing


