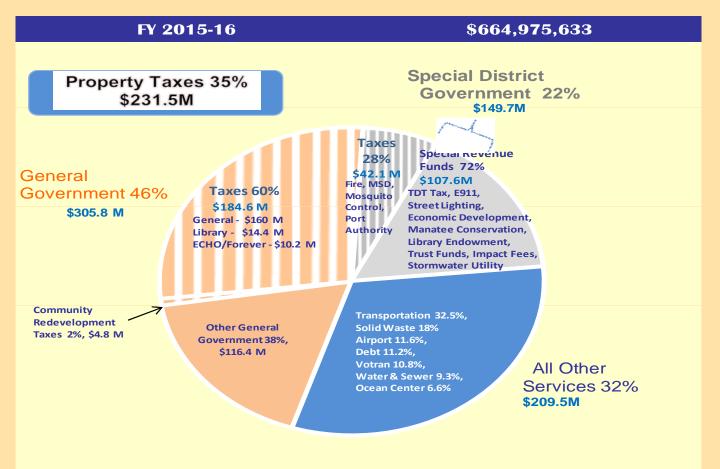

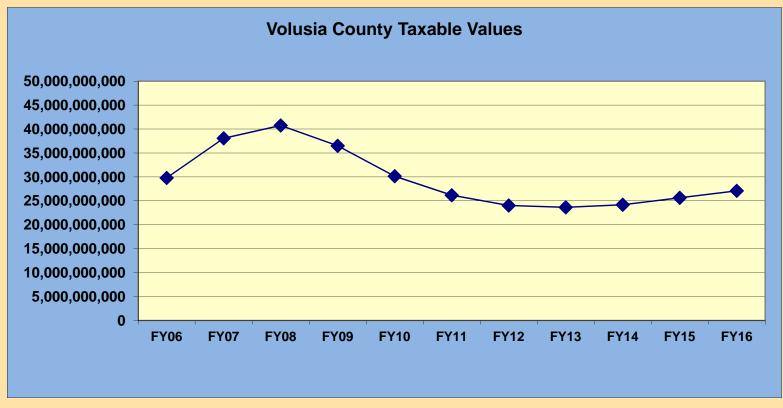

## Countywide Taxable Value

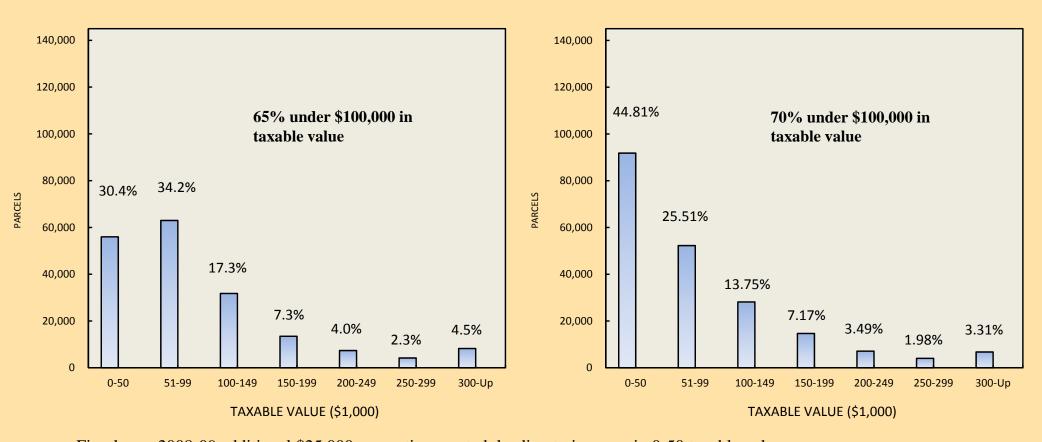


2016 values are below 2005 levels, however the growth of the dollar 2005 to ending 2015 (CPI) grew 22%

Fiscal Year 2015-16

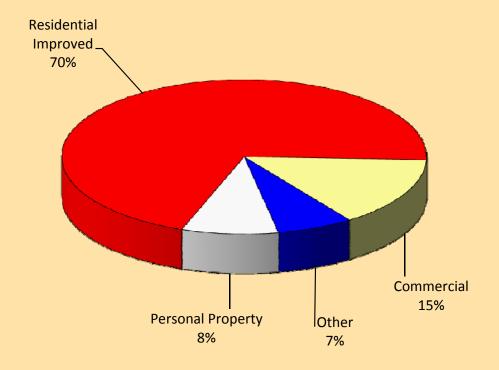

## Classification of Property

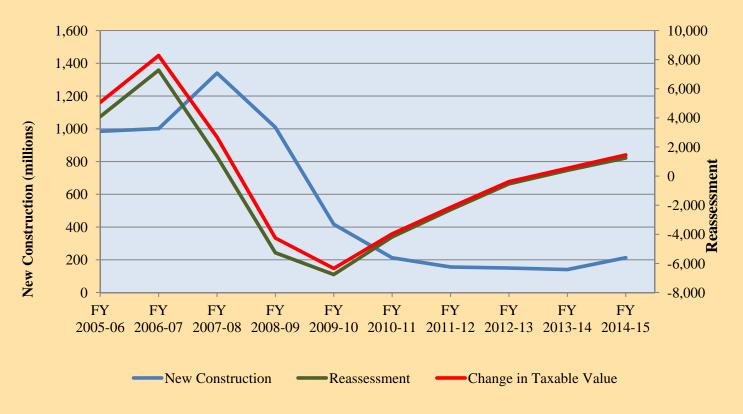

# New Construction & Reassessments



The County is entering into its third year of slight increases in property values, after five consecutive years of declining values. The countywide value increased 5.7% to \$27 billion with 4.6% increase from reassessments and 1.1% from new construction added to the tax rolls. Even with these changes, the values are still below fiscal year 2006 "pre-bubble" levels.

### General Fund Residential Homeowner

#### Fiscal Year 2005-06

- 65% under \$100,000 taxable value
- Average taxable value is \$108,130
- Homeowner average taxes paid \$573
- Fiscal year 2008-09 additional \$25,000 exemption given

#### Fiscal Year 2015-16

- 70% under \$100,000 taxable value
- Average taxable value is \$89,069
- Homeowner average taxes paid \$522
- Fiscal year 2005-06 average taxes paid adjusted by average CPI of 2.3% would be \$718

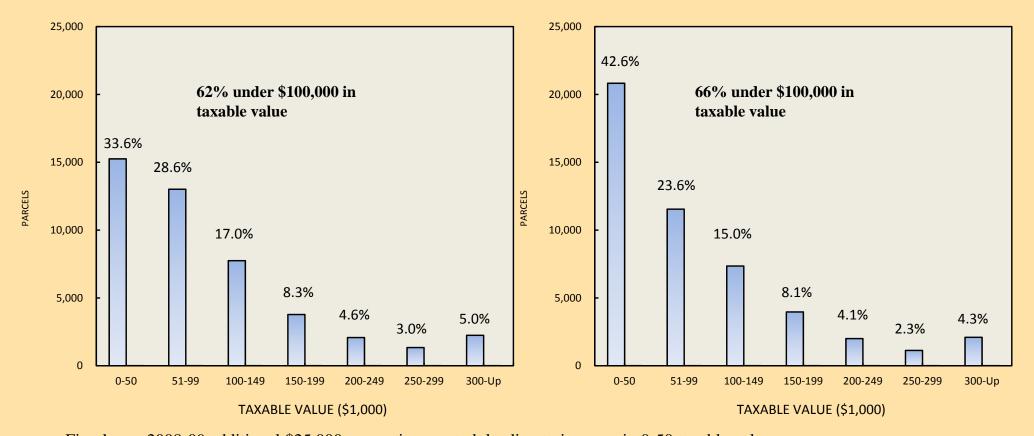

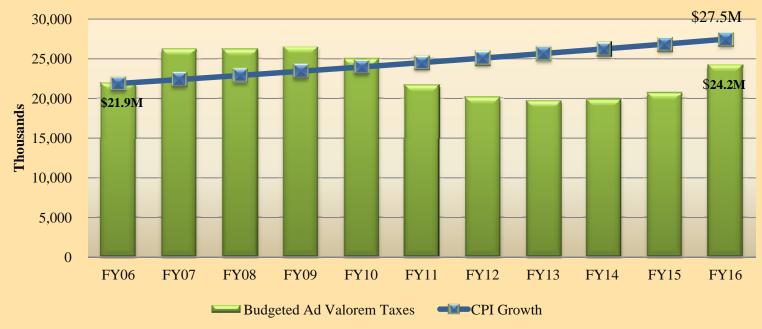

#### Fiscal Year 2015-16

- 66% under \$100,000 value
- Average taxable value is \$94,935
- Homeowner average taxes paid \$330
- Fiscal year 2005-06 average taxes paid adjusted by average CPI of 2.3% would be \$344
