Unsecured compressed cylinders.



Blocked electrical panel.



Poor housekeeping.



Passports are designed to identify the number of personnel on a unit not how many personnel are at a fire station. There are only two members assigned to

this unit and two pars tags should be displayed on this passport. According to this passport, there should be five members reporting.



Fire extinguishers are considered compressed cylinders and should be secured from falling.



Store paints and chemicals in proper locations. Do not store inside the living area.



Label containers with the appropriate chemical being used for example, window cleaner, degreaser, or Armor All.



Rated fire doors shall be closed at all time.
