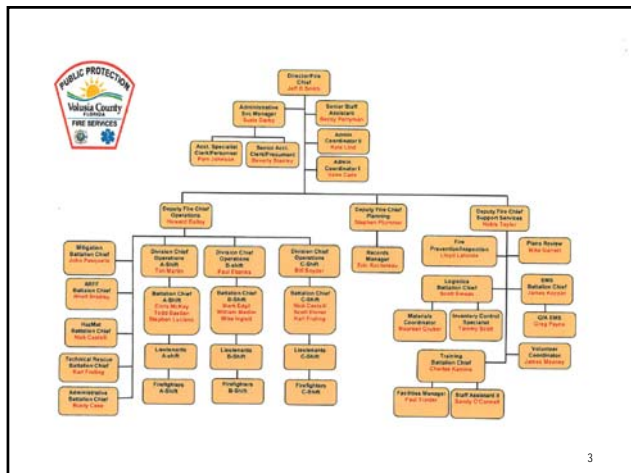

Total Number of Fire Prevention Public Contacts - 3,421

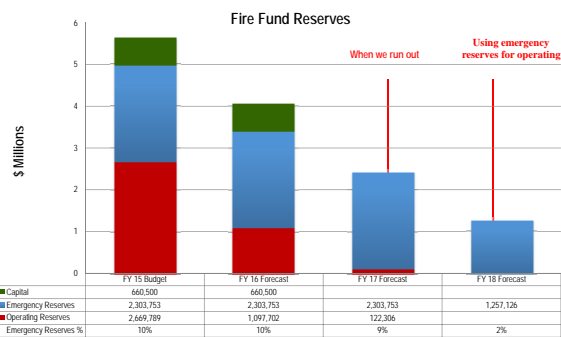

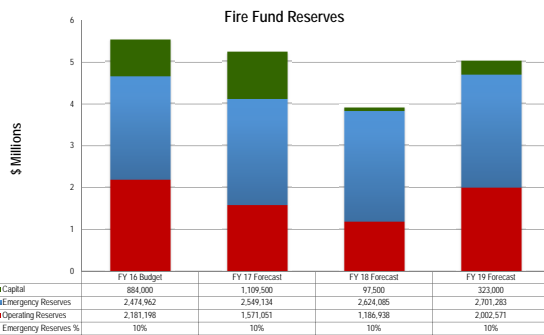
