SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

\$2,000 for educational scholarships will be made available each year through the combined efforts of the Volusia County Cattlemen and the Volusia County Cattlewomen's Associations. The intent of the scholarship is to assist a college student from Volusia County with an interest in agriculture. This scholarship will be given in increments of \$500.00 or more but the maximum amount one applicant can receive is \$2,000.00. An applicant may reapply for this scholarship until a total of \$2,000.00 has been awarded, or until they are no longer eligible.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants must be:

- A current or former resident of Volusia County
- High school senior or college student at an accredited institution
- Member in good standing of a Volusia county 4-H chapter or FFA chapter
- College students are not required to be active in 4-H or FFA but must show an interest in agriculture through their major and/or coursework

INFORMATION RELEVANT TO THE SCHOLARSHIP:

- Upon receipt of college information, the scholarship will be sent directly to the school for disbursement.
- The scholarship(s) will be presented at Cracker Day, April 28, 2018.
- Applicants may apply as many times as they desire but can only be awarded a total of \$2,000.00.
- Application criteria is subject to change annually.
- Confidentiality will be respected.
- The chairperson of the committee will notify all applicants regarding their application status before the winner(s) are announced.
