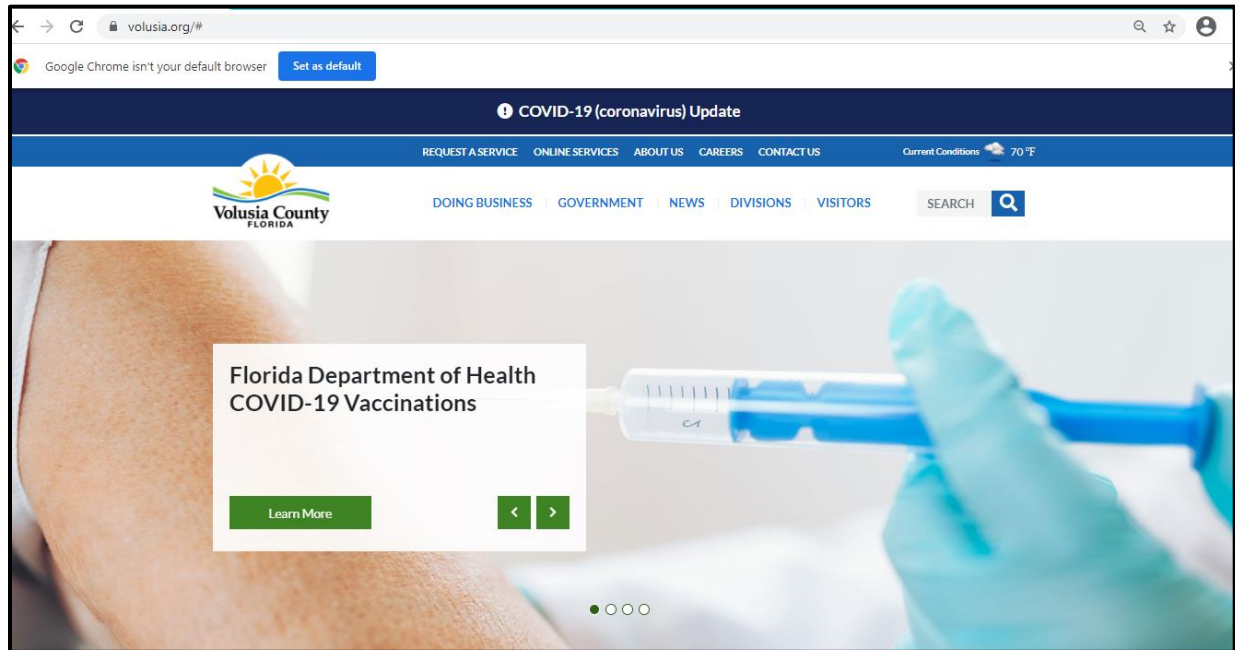


Volusia County Government Activities

Major Capital Projects:

LED Lighting: One hundred percent of construction documents are complete; work continues on the frontend documents with The Purchasing Divisions getting everything ready to go out to bid.

Garage Decking: Work has begun on the Parking Garage Level 2 Deck Rehabilitation project and continues to progress as planned.

Sound System: Work has begun on the replacement of the sound system. A sample satellite speaker array was affixed temporarily to get final measurements for rigging the hardware. The system equipment is being assembled at the contractor's facility and will be brought to the Ocean Center after testing.
