

RESOLUTION 2018-108

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA ADOPTING A FEE SCHEDULE AS AUTHORIZED BY CHAPTER 72, LAND PLANNING, ARTICLE II ZONING, DIVISION 9, ADMINISTRATION AND VIOLATIONS, SECTION 72-341(g) ADMINISTRATION, FEE SCHEDULES; REPEALING AND REPLACING RESOLUTION 2012-130 AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 72, Land Planning, Article II Zoning, Division 9, Administration and Violations, Section 72-341(g) Administration, Fee Schedules provides for establishment of fee schedules by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the fee schedule should be updated from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the County Council finds that an additional fee should be added for conditional use permits as allowed by Ordinance 2018-13; and

WHEREAS, the County Council of Volusia County, Florida has determined that the adoption of this amended fee schedule is in the interest of the public health, safety, and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN OPEN MEETING DULY ASSEMBLED IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS OF THE THOMAS C. KELLY ADMINISTRATIVE CENTER, 123 WEST INDIANA AVENUE, DELAND, FLORIDA, THIS 7th DAY OF AUGUST, 2018 A.D., AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The amended fee schedule is attached hereto as Exhibit A and is hereby adopted pursuant to Chapter 72 Land Planning, Article II Zoning, Division 9 of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION II: Resolution 2012-130 is hereby repealed in its entirety.


SECTION III: This resolution shall take effect upon the effective date of Ordinance No. 2018-13.



¹ Term of this license shall begin on October 1 and end of September 30 of each year regardless of the date of issuance.

² Terms of these licenses shall begin on January 1 and end on June 30 of each year, or begin on July 1 and end on December 31 of each year, regardless of the date of issuance.
