Amendment Notice

This notice is intended to provide citizens with reasonable notice and opportunity to comment on proposed changes to the County of Volusia's Neighborhood Stabilization Program 3 Action Plan. This amendment transfers the remaining budget of \$234,624 from activity #4 for low-income rental to activity #6 for the redevelopment of vacant lots owned in the NSP3 areas of greatest need within neighborhoods in DeLand and Orange City by constructing and reselling single-family homes to low to middle-income households (120% or less of the area median income). Activity 4 will be cancelled.

NOTICE UNDER THE AMERICANS
