2 ~~council districts, with the remaining members appointed at large. The board shall~~  
3 ~~have nine members, each of which shall be an elector of the county. The county~~  
4 ~~council shall appoint a board member upon the nomination of a council member.~~  
5 ~~Each district council member shall make one nomination. The at-large member and~~  
6 ~~the County Chair shall each make two nominations, one elector from the West side~~  
7 ~~of the county and one elector from the East side of the county. No elected official,~~  
8 ~~appointed state, county or municipal office holder, member of two or more other~~  
9 ~~county boards or commissions, or employee of county government shall be~~  
10 ~~appointed to serve on the board.~~ Members may be appointed from either or both  
11 the incorporated or unincorporated areas of the county. Board members may be  
12 professionals from the disciplines of architecture, history, architectural history,  
13 archaeology, anthropology, cultural geography, planning or other related disciplines  
14 or citizens who have demonstrated special interest, experience or knowledge in  
15 history, archaeology, architecture or related disciplines.

16 (2) Term. ~~Except as otherwise provided herein, m~~Members of the board shall be  
17 appointed by the county council to serve for a term of two years. Board members  
18 shall be eligible for reappointment. ~~However, the term of each member previously~~  
19 ~~appointed to a three-year term pursuant to this section shall continue automatically,~~  
20 ~~but said term shall expire March 31, 2001. Any member whose term expires before~~  
21 ~~March 31, 2001 is hereby reappointed to serve until March 31, 2001. Beginning~~

1           ~~March 31, 2001, no member shall serve in office for more than three consecutive~~  
2           ~~two-year terms.~~

3           (3) Vacancies and Removal. ~~In the event of a vacancy on the board, the county~~  
4           ~~council shall appoint a new member to serve out the remainder of the term within 60 days~~  
5           ~~of the occurrence of said vacancy. If any member fails to attend two meetings during any~~  
6           ~~calendar year ending December 31, regardless of the reason, the member's seat shall be~~  
7           ~~deemed vacant. Any member of the board may be removed from office without cause by~~  
8           ~~the county council. A board vacancy shall be filled upon nomination by the council member~~  
9           ~~who shall have made the nomination to the vacated position or the successor to that~~  
10           ~~council member. Appointments to fill any vacancy shall be for the remainder of the~~  
11           ~~unexpired term.~~

12           ~~(4) Removal from office. If a member is absent for three consecutive meetings~~  
13           ~~without being excused prior to said meeting by the chairman, said member shall~~  
14           ~~forfeit his office and it shall be deemed vacant. Any member of the commission may~~  
15           ~~be removed from office for cause by the county council, upon written charges and~~  
16           ~~after public hearing.~~


18           **SECTION II: AUTHORIZING INCLUSION IN CODE** - The provisions of this  
19           ordinance shall be included and incorporated into the Code of Ordinances of the County of  
20           Volusia, as additions or amendments thereto, and shall be appropriately renumbered to  
21           conform to the uniform numbering system of the Code.

1           **SECTION III: SEVERABILITY** - Should any word, phrase, sentence, subsection or  
2 section be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, void, unenforceable, or  
3 unconstitutional, then that word, phrase, sentence, subsection or section so held shall be  
4 severed from this ordinance and all other words, phrases, sentences, subsections, or  
5 sections shall remain in full force and effect.


6           **SECTION IV: CONFLICTING ORDINANCES**- This ordinance shall prevail over any  
7 other conflicting resolution or ordinance.

8           **SECTION V: EFFECTIVE DATE** - A certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed  
9 with the Department of State by the County Manager within ten (10) days after enactment  
10 by the County Council and this Ordinance shall take effect upon filing with the Department  
11 of State.
