

FCC Environmental Services will begin providing waste collection services to your home April 1.



HOW WILL THIS AFFECT YOU?

Your collection days ***will not*** change.

- Continue to use the same 95-gallon blue garbage cart and recycling bin(s).

CURBSIDE COLLECTION

- Place waste and recycling bins curbside by 6 a.m. on your pickup day. Pickup is between 6 a.m. and 8 p.m.
- **Garbage** pickup is once a week in the blue garbage cart

► **New:** Excess garbage may be placed in up to two 32-gallon containers next to the cart.

- **Bulky items** – such as furniture, appliances, carpet, tires, etc. – are collected once a week.

► **New:** Bulky items do not need to be scheduled up to four items will be collected on garbage day if they are curbside.



Construction and demolition debris, household hazardous waste and other toxic materials **are not** accepted curbside.



- **Recycling** is collected once a week. The following items may be recycled:

- **Mixed paper** – newspaper, corrugated cardboard, cereal boxes without liners, drink and snack boxes, and junk mail.
- **Containers** – aluminum and steel cans, glass bottles, and plastic containers coded 1 & 2. Rinse containers thoroughly.

Flatten or fold large cardboard boxes to two feet by two feet. ***Do not bundle or tie the boxes.***

No plastic bags or Styrofoam, please!

- **Yard waste** (*grass, leaves, shrub and tree trimmings*)
 - Up to eight 32-gallon containers (*or the equivalent*) may be placed by the curb each week, not to exceed four cubic yards per week.
 - Palm fronds and limbs must be neatly stacked (*no need to bundle*).
 - Limbs may not exceed four feet in length and one foot in diameter and must weigh less than 60 pounds.
