




#### Florida Springs and Aquifer Protection Act

Protects 30 Florida Springs Threatened by Excess Nitrogen Pollution




### Florida Springs and Aquifer Protection Act

### **Actions Mandated by Senate Bill 552**

Must establish Priority Focus Areas for all first-magnitude springs

### **Actions Mandated by Senate Bill 552**

□ Septic System Remediation Plans required for areas with more than 20% septic system nitrogen contribution or as deemed appropriate by FDEP








### **DeLeon Spring**

Major Nitrogen Contributors


- ☐ Farm Fertilizer (52%)

- ☐ Septic Systems (14%)








### **How Septic Systems Impact Springs**

### Nitrogen Must Be Reduced to Protect Spring Water Quality




## State-Mandated Septic System Remediation Plan <u>ELEMENTS</u>

- Scientific information on the effect of nutrients on the spring
- Options for nutrient reducing septic system alternatives
- Public education plan
- Cost-effective and financially feasible projects
- A priority ranking for each project for funding




# State-Mandated Septic System Remediation Plan OPTION

- Connect to central sewer system
  - Initial cost to connect, monthly sewer bills




# State-Mandated Septic System Remediation Plan OPTION


- Install a Nitrogen-Reducing Aerobic Treatment Unit
  - Systems require maintenance entities, service contract agreements and operating permits



## State-Mandated Septic System Remediation Plan OPTION

- Install Distributed Sewer Network
  - Centrally managed performance-based treatment units at each home
  - Systems require wireless connection and supervision by a professional wastewater operator
  - Initial installation cost, monthly sewer bills






