Irma Cost Recovery Update #6

When a Federal disaster is declared, FEMA can reimburse affected entities a percent of their costs. President Trump signed an Emergency Declaration for Hurricane Irma, which included Florida and Volusia County on September 10, 2017. This allowed FEMA to reimburse a percent of emergency costs including Emergency Protective Measures (Category B) and Debris Removal (Category A). The County has since been approved for the remaining Categories C-G for permanent repairs.

Debris removal (Category A) includes the removal of debris as well as the debris monitoring company required by FEMA. As of December 12, 2020, the County had over 814,000 cubic yards of debris removed, reduced, mulched, and monitored for an estimated cost of \$14,613,248. Normally, maintenance of HOA and private roads are the responsibility of the property owners. However, the County submitted documentation to FEMA that was judged to qualify the County for FEMA reimbursement for removal of vegetative debris from HOAs and private roads. The total cost of HOA and private road debris removal is estimated to be \$1,205,510, and is included in the total estimated cost previously stated. As of December 12, 2020, the County has received \$13,305,483 in reimbursements from FEMA and the State for debris removal.

Emergency protective measures (Category B) includes pre-storm preparations to secure locations, hand out sandbags, stage essential personnel and equipment, evacuate patients from hospitals and other facilities, and prepare evacuation shelters as well as other pre-storm activities. It also includes activities during the storm including staffing the Emergency Operations Center with extra personnel to answer phones, personnel to work in shelters, extra sheriff patrols, and fire services as well as other services. Immediately after the storm, emergency protective services include clearing roads and walkways of downed powerlines and trees. As of December 12, 2020, excluding the cost of temporary locations for the former occupants of 250 North Beach Street and the cost of reimbursing the school board for sheltering expenses, the County had estimated costs of \$2,803,808 in Emergency Protective Measures. The County estimates a total of \$3,467,741 in additional costs for Emergency Protective Measures for temporary locations for the former occupants of 250 North Beach Street. In addition, the school board has reported estimated costs of \$581,960 for sheltering operations during Hurricane Irma. Emergency protective measures in total are estimated to cost \$6,835,509.

As of December 12, 2020, the County has received \$2,888,756 in insurance proceeds and expects to receive an additional \$1,550,193 in insurance proceeds for emergency protective measures. After reducing for received and estimated insurance proceeds as well as county match other adjustments totaling \$40,476, \$2,374,084 in emergency costs remain for FEMA and State reimbursement. As of December 12, 2020, the County has received \$600,398 in reimbursements from FEMA and the State for emergency protective measures.

Roads and Bridges (Category C) includes work to repair surfaces, bases, shoulders, ditches, and drainage structures. As of December 12, 2020, the County has estimated repair costs of \$683,832. As of December 12, 2020, the County has received \$78,504 in reimbursements from FEMA and the State for roads and bridges.

Buildings and Equipment (Category E) includes damage to buildings and equipment as well as the equipment usage, cleaning and treatment of mold, and replacement of inventory destroyed or consumed for the disaster. As of December 12, 2020, the County has estimated repair and/or replacement costs of \$1,770,993 for Category E damages not including expenses related to 250 N Beach Street. As of

December 12, 2020, the County has received \$485,008 in reimbursements from FEMA and the State for buildings and equipment.

Utilities (Category F) includes damages to water treatment plants, power facilities, and communications. As of December 12, 2020, the County has estimated repair costs of \$47,705 for Category F damages. As of December 12, 2020, the County has received \$19,596 in reimbursements from FEMA and the State for utilities.

Parks, Recreational Facilities, and Other (Category G) includes parks, beaches, and other items that do not fit into the other categories. As of December 12, 2020, the County has estimated repair costs of \$1,358,558. As of December 12, 2020, the County has received \$123,373 in reimbursements from FEMA and the State for parks, recreational facilities and other.

The County has submitted Project Worksheets for actual and/or estimated costs to FEMA. The State coordinates with FEMA. FEMA and/or the State can approve, deny, or modify requests. Once approved, FEMA generally reimburses up to 75% of the approved amount. The State will reimburse half of the remaining amount. The County is responsible for the remainder. FEMA has a program that allows for a slightly higher reimbursement for Category A costs depending on when the work was completed. In addition, the President approved Category B as 100% for the first 30 days of the Hurricane Irma incident period. The Governor requested and FEMA subsequently approved an increase FEMA's share to 90% on all projects except the projects already at a higher share.

As of December 12, 2020, the County has total estimated costs of \$26,127,845 including \$800,000 in direct administrative costs but excluding the cost of permanent repairs related to 250 N Beach Street. Insurance is expected to pay a large amount toward permanent work, especially on 250 North Beach Street and the City Island Library, however, the County is awaiting determination from its insurance carriers on the amount to be covered. The County has received a partial insurance amount of \$3,399,094 meant to cover part of the total estimated costs. The remaining insurance expected is \$1,561,731 with an additional undetermined amount expected related to permanent repairs for 250 N Beach Street. The County has received \$14,612,362 from FEMA and the State as of December 12, 2020. If all remaining costs submitted to FEMA are approved, the County should receive an additional \$5,228,800 from FEMA and the State for a total of \$19,841,162. The County's match requirement, including small project variances, is \$1,325,858.
