# Volusia County Fire Rescue Permit Requirements

## General Permitting Requirements

- For new construction, site/civil plans must be approved prior to the submission of any structural plans being reviewed
- o Plans shall be submitted to the Volusia County Building Department or through Connectlive

## Minimum Requirements for Specific Permit Type

#### New Construction / Build-Outs

- o List of the most current building and NFPA codes used in developing the plans
- o Business name and address on each page
- o A Life Safety Plan (LSP) to include all the following
  - Type of occupancy
  - Occupant load calculations
  - o Common paths of travel and distances to exits
  - o Corridor width
  - Fire extinguisher location(s)
  - Emergency lighting\*
  - Illuminated exit signage\*

\*may be on the lighting/reflective ceiling plan or the LSP, but if on both they must be identical

- o If mechanical plans for systems greater than 2000 CFM or 60,000 BTUs supply side duct detectors are required, with their respective test switches
- o If mechanical plans in a non-sprinklered/non-fire alarm building, the proper location of the respective test switches AND the location of each "smoke" indicator
- o If electrical plans, the panel schedule needs to indicate which breaker is for the emergency lighting and which breaker is for the fire alarm control panel "FACP" in an alarmed structure
- o If lighting plans, the location of all illuminated exit signs and emergency lighting must match that of the LSP
- o Any fire system related work shall require a sub-permit from the specific trade performing the work

#### Fire Sprinkler Permit Requirements

- o Permit required if installation/alteration is greater than five heads
- List of the current NFPA code(s) used in developing the plans
- o Business name and address on each page
- o Plans shall be submitted to the Volusia County Building Department or through Connectlive
- All manufacture product (cut) sheets
- o Hangar details
- o If greater than 49 heads, an engineer's stamp is required

## Fire Alarm Permit Requirements

- o Permit required for all alterations and installation
- List of the current NFPA code(s) used in developing the plans
- o Business name and address on each page
- o Plans shall be submitted to Volusia County Building Department or through Connectlive
- All manufacture product (cut) sheets
- o If system is wireless, then a map showing the primary and alternate(s) cell/radio towers should the primary fail
- o If greater than \$5000 value, an engineer's stamp is required

## Fire Suppression Permit Requirements

#### UL-300 (Kitchen Suppression Systems)

- o Permit required for all installations and alterations
- List of the current NFPA code(s) used in developing the plans
- o Business name and address on each page
- o Plans shall be submitted to the Volusia County Building Department or through Connectlive
- Sequence of operations on the drawings
- o All manufacture product (cut) sheets

#### FM-200 (Clean Rooms)

- Permit required for all installations and alterations
- o List of the current NFPA code(s) used in developing the plans
- Business name and address on each page
- o Plans shall be submitted to the Volusia County Building Department or through Connectlive
- Sequence of operations on all drawings
- o All manufacture product (cut) sheets

#### Tent Permit Requirements

- o Submit plans with zoning and building department with applicable permit
- o Tents that meet fire rating are required. Submit documentation of the rating
- Map of location showing the location of the tent with exits
- o Tent is required to have illuminated exit and emergency lights
- Minimum of one fire extinguisher every 75 feet

## Special Event Permit Requirements

- o Completion of the Volusia County Special Event Permit application
- Submit plans indicating tent location a minimum of 10 feet apart, food vendors 10 feet apart and emergency ingress and egress
- o Emergency action plan
- Map of the event location
- o Tent permit for all commercially installed temporary tents

### Firework Permit Requirements

- o Completion of the specific Outdoor Fireworks Display Permit application.
- o Evidence of financial responsibility of the property owner
- Evidence of financial responsibility of the operator
- Qualifications of all operators and assistants
- o Clear driver's license photo of each operator and assistant
- Letter from the Homeowner's Associations (HOA) granting permission for the display if located in a development
- o The quantity, a detailed inventory and manufacture product specifications of each firework to be shot off
- Map of the event location showing all stand-off distances, fall-out distances, audience location, roads and buildings within range of the display and the location of the vehicle used to store the fireworks
- o 24/7 name and number of the event organizer
- o 24/7 name and number of the display operator
