County Road System:


- Paved Roads 973 centerline miles / 2,042 lane miles
- Dirt Roads 81 miles
- Emergency Maintenance Roads 86 miles
- Sidewalks 282 miles
- Traffic Signals 341 traffic signals (includes: County, FDOT & Cities)

Budget for road maintenance is <u>+</u>\$20 million/year.








ROAD RESURFACING




ROAD PROGRAM FUNDING

County Road Projects are funded by:


- Gas Tax 12 cents/gallon includes 5 cents specifically for construction of capacity projects. (Countywide)
- Impact Fees Generated by new development specifically for capacity projects. (Zones)
- Proportionate Fair Share Generated by new development in congested traffic areas specifically for capacity projects. (Zones)
- Grants State/Federal project grants for capacity or safety projects, eg LAP & TRIP grants. (Project specific)

No property taxes are used to fund road projects.
