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- (i) The 2011 East Central Florida Hurricane Evacuation Study update provides estimates for in-County clearance times derived through a transportation modeling process. The study's estimates for 2010 are as follows:

CATEGORY 1/2	9/13 hours
CATEGORY 3	18/20 hours
CATEGORY 4/5	24/38 hours

Evacuation decisions will be timed to provide the at-risk population the maximum amount of time to safely evacuate based upon each hurricane scenario.

6. Emergency transportation

- (a) Evacuees requiring transportation assistance may use public transportation generally available within the areas to be evacuated and is coordinated through ESF 1. Public transportation will assist evacuees who cannot drive or have no other means of transportation. All evacuees using emergency transportation will be taken to public shelters. Transportation will also be available to return to the evacuated areas after reentry is authorized.
- (b) Evacuation of non-ambulatory personnel will be coordinated through ESFs 1, 8, and 4/9 as required. Transportation and medical requirements will be considered in establishing procedures to move these personnel to safe shelter. Individuals who are not in residential health care facilities but require special medical attention will be moved to special needs shelters or preferably to the home of a relative or friend by prior arrangements with parties involved. Individuals requiring either transportation and/or special medical assistance during emergencies are urged to register in the special needs database through Volusia County Emergency Management Services. Individuals requiring assistance during emergencies should call VOTRAN using the telephone numbers advertised in the Disaster Preparedness Guide.
- (c) Personnel who evacuate and who desire to take companion pets (dogs, cats) with them to public shelters must plan to use the People and Pet Shelter locations advertised in the Disaster Preparedness Guide. All pets must be in pet carriers or containers.
- (d) Personnel located within areas considered at-risk covered in evacuation orders who indicate potential inability to care for themselves and who refuse to evacuate only because they do not desire to be separated from their companion pets (dogs, cats) may be evacuated to the closest appropriate public shelter with pets on a case by case basis, based upon the discretion of emergency personnel involved with evacuation notification and enforcement. In these circumstances, pets must be transported in pet carriers. Pets will be located in a separate location as determined by the receiving public shelter manager. Every reasonable attempt must be made to relocate people from areas that are at significant risk based on the apparent hazards and time-constrained situations.

7. Drawbridges

- (a) Volusia County has seven drawbridges, five on the Halifax River and two on the St. Johns River. Three of these bridges are controlled by Volusia County (Highbridge, Mainstreet, and Silver Beach/Orange Avenue) and three are controlled by the State (Astor, N. Bridge, and Whitehair).
- (b) During the latter stages of a hurricane evacuation, it will become necessary to "lockdown" the lifting spans of the drawbridges (when winds reach 39 MPH sustained). This action, taken by the agency responsible for bridge tending operations in coordination with the United States Coast Guard, will protect the moving parts of the bridge during the anticipated strong winds. Upon completion of "lockdown" marine traffic will not be able to proceed through that bridge. The authority to regulate marine traffic as supported by drawbridge operations rests with the U.S. Coast Guard and must be further coordinated with agencies represented within the VCEOC in accordance with the FDOT District 5 Movable Bridge Emergency Operation Plan. ESF 16 has lead responsibility as supported by ESF 3 (Public Works- Bridge Division), the U.S. Coast Guard, and FDOT liaison at the CEOC.
- (c) In the interim period after issuance of the evacuation order and before total "lockdown" is executed, drawbridges will be raised on the hour (**ONLY IF BOAT TRAFFIC IS PRESENT**) as approved by the USCG. Action taken to "lockdown" drawbridges may be initiated by controlling agencies (FDOT, Volusia County, and USCG) as early as necessary (generally within an eight hour period immediately before the anticipated arrival of tropical storm force winds) in order to complete "lockdown" before these damaging winds arrive. Termination of "lockdown" actions will be based upon public safety assessments associated with re-entry authorizations.
- (d) Traffic direction flow over all bridges (high-rises and drawbridges) from the north and south peninsula to mainland locations will be the same as experienced during normal day-to-day traffic operations. Unless otherwise noted, **ALL BRIDGES WILL HAVE TWO-WAY TRAFFIC DURING PERIODS OF MANDATORY EVACUATION IN ORDER TO MINIMIZE CONFUSION AND PROMOTE SAFE TRAFFIC FLOW.**
- (e) Once mandatory evacuation has begun, municipal law enforcement agencies responsible for traffic control of bridges within their jurisdiction, will closely monitor and progressively tighten restrictions on eastbound traffic over the bridges. At a point in time close to the pending arrival of tropical storm-force winds, law enforcement agencies will prohibit eastbound entry over bridges except for emergency vehicles, and other public service providers as may be required within reasonable safety precautions.

8. Re-entry After Evacuations

- (a) **General Re-entry.** The Volusia County Sheriff has authority over re-entry to all previously evacuated areas. General reentry to all areas previously evacuated will be authorized based upon public safety and security concerns, operational requirements for search and rescue, and the need to reestablish property owners on their property. This reentry policy will be established as soon as possible and with as few restrictions and limitations as possible coincidental with public safety requirements. The decision to establish general reentry will be evaluated through continuous coordination among the various county and state agencies, municipal law enforcement agencies, and adjacent

counties. Based upon these concerns and the information available from local and state agencies, the Director of Emergency Management will recommend general reentry actions for Manager's Advisory Group approval. The Manager's Advisory Group has the authority and will establish times, procedures, and any restrictions to allow reentry to evacuated areas and to recommend for County Council action to terminate any local declaration of a state of emergency. Under the most severe scenarios, reentry will most likely be a geographically dependent, gradual process depending on the extent and location of damage throughout the County.

- (b) **Coordination Procedures.** In all areas, general reentry will be prohibited until the area in question has been declared safe as determined by the County and municipalities. Appropriate agencies (i.e. law enforcement, Public Works, utilities, fire, search and rescue and property appraisers) will advise the Director of Emergency Management *if and when* an area is considered safe for general reentry. Reentry to evacuated areas must be coordinated through VCSO among municipal law enforcement agencies, as well as with adjacent counties to ensure adequate traffic control and security for residents returning to the evacuated areas. Bridges, while under the operational traffic control of the municipality in which it is located, will not re-open until all coordination is completed. Unless otherwise advised by the Manager's Advisory Group of the VCEOC, all general and restricted reentry times and locations must be coordinated before enforcement agencies take action and the public is notified. General and Special Needs Shelter staff will be notified by ESF 2 when general re-entry has been authorized.
- (c) **Restricted Re-entry.** Restricted Re-entry to areas will be established when all or segments of areas evacuated have been subjected to disaster damages that make them either not completely safe or accessible for general return of residents and other property owners *en masse*. Access to the restricted areas will be based upon general need of property owners to assess and initiate repair of damages, restoration of infrastructure services and governmental operations associated with disaster management **ONLY**. Security check points will be established and operated by the jurisdiction(s) involved. Procedures will accommodate a limited number of access based upon the positive identification of personnel authorized to the limited access areas under the categories previously noted. Any questions or unusual circumstances not covered by existing re-entry instructions should be immediately forwarded to the jurisdiction for resolution or for further forwarding to the CEOC for additional coordination and resolution.

BE PREPARED....BE SAFE BEFORE, DURING AND AFTER A FLOOD



Before A Flood

Familiarize yourself with these terms to help identify the severity of flood impacts in the corresponding river/stream reach:

- **Action stage** – water surface is generally near or slightly above the top of its banks, but no man-made structures are flooded. Typically, any water overflowing is limited to small areas of parkland and marshland.
- **Minor flooding** – minimal or no property damage, but possibly some public threat.
- **Moderate flooding** – some inundation of structures and roads near stream. Some evacuations of people and/or transfer of property to higher elevations.
- **Major flooding** – extensive inundation of structures and roads. Significant evacuations of people and/or transfer of property to higher elevations.
- **Record flooding** – flooding that equals or exceeds the highest stage or discharge at a given site during the period of record keeping.

To prepare for a flood:

- Investigate flood insurance for your home. Homes that aren't in a flood plain can be at risk for flash floods or damage due to heavy rains. Standard homeowners policies do not cover flood damage caused by rising water. There is a 30-day waiting period from the time you purchase flood insurance to the time it takes effect. Flood insurance, administered through FEMA's National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP), can be purchased through local insurance agents. Residents can call 888-379-9531 or go online to www.FloodSmart.gov to estimate flood risks or insurance premiums for their neighborhoods, or contact their insurance agent.
- Elevate the air conditioner/heater, water heater, and electric panel if susceptible to flooding.
- Install "check valves" in sewer traps to prevent flood water from backing up into the drains of your home.
- Construct barriers (levees, beams, floodwalls) to stop floodwater from entering the building.
- If necessary sandbag all entrances to your home.

If you must prepare to evacuate:

- Secure your home. If you have time, bring in outdoor furniture. Move essential items to an upper floor.
- Turn off utilities at the main switches or valves if instructed to do so. Disconnect electrical appliances. Do not touch electrical equipment if you are wet or standing in water.

During a Flood

If a flood is likely in your area:

- Listen to the radio or television for information.
- Be aware that flash flooding can occur. If there is any possibility of a flash flood, move immediately to higher ground. Do not wait for instructions to move.

If you have to leave your home:

- Do not walk through moving water. Six inches of moving water can make you fall. If you have to walk in water, walk where the water is not moving. Use a stick to check the firmness of the ground in front of you.
- Do not drive into flooded areas. If floodwaters rise around your car, abandon the car and move to higher ground if you can do so safely. You and the vehicle can be quickly swept away.
- Six inches of water will reach the bottom of most passenger cars causing loss of control and possible stalling.
- A foot of water will float many vehicles.
- Two feet of rushing water can carry away most vehicles including sport utility vehicles (SUVs) and pick-ups.



After a Flood

- Listen for news reports to learn whether the community's water supply is safe to drink.
- Avoid floodwaters; water may be contaminated by oil, gasoline, or raw sewage. Water may also be electrically charged from underground or downed power lines.
- Avoid moving water.
- Be aware of areas where floodwaters have receded. Roads may have weakened and could collapse under the weight of a car.
- Stay out of any building if it is surrounded by floodwaters.
- Service damaged septic tanks, cesspools, pits and leaching systems as soon as possible. Damaged sewage systems are serious health hazards.
- Clean and disinfect everything that got wet. Mud left from floodwater can contain sewage and chemicals.

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What To Do Before, During, and After Flooding

The safe way to deal with a flood? Go somewhere else. Stay somewhere else. And be absolutely safe when returning to a flood zone.

Here's our best advice on how to do that:



BEFORE A FLOOD (When Flooding is Forecast)

Be alert.

- Monitor your surroundings.
- Monitor NOAA Weather Radio, local television and radio stations, or go to www.weather.gov and www.volusia.org/emergency

If a **flood warning** is issued for your area: **Take action immediately.**

- In Volusia County, floods develop over a period of hours. Do not wait until you see rising water to take action!

- Get out of low areas subject to flooding.
- If driving, do not drive through flooded roadways! "Turn around, don't drown!"

Assemble disaster supplies:

- Drinking water – Fill clean containers.
- Food that requires no refrigeration or cooking.
- Cash.
- Medications and first aid supplies.
- Clothing, toiletries.
- Battery-powered radio.
- Flashlights.
- Extra batteries.
- Important documents: insurance papers, medical records, bank account numbers.

Be prepared to evacuate.

- Identify places to go.
- Identify alternative travel routes that are not prone to flooding.
- Plan what to do with your pets.
- Fill your car's gas tank.
- If told to leave, do so quickly.

Review your Family Disaster Plan.

- Discuss flood plans with your family.
- Decide where you will meet if separated.
- Designate a contact person who can be reached if family members get separated. Make sure every family member has the contact information.

Protect your property.

- Move valuables and furniture to higher levels.
- Move hazardous materials (such as paint, oil, pesticides, and cleaning supplies) to higher locations.
- Disconnect electrical appliances. Do not touch them if you are wet or standing in water.
- Bring outside possessions indoors or tie them down securely. This includes lawn furniture, garbage cans, and other movable objects.
- Seal vents to basements to prevent flooding.

DURING A FLOOD

Be alert.

- Monitor your surroundings.

- Monitor NOAA Weather Radio, local television and radio stations, or go to www.weather.gov and www.volusia.org/emergnecy

Don't drive unless you have to.

If you must drive, travel with care.

- Make sure your vehicle has enough fuel.
- Follow recommended routes. DO NOT sightsee.
- Avoid disaster areas. Your presence might hamper rescue or other emergency operations and put you at further risk.
- Watch for washed out roads, earth slides, and downed trees or power lines.
- Be especially cautious at night, when it is harder to recognize flood dangers.
- If the vehicle stalls, abandon it.
- If water rises around your car, leave the vehicle immediately. Climb to higher ground as quickly as possible.

NEVER drive through flooded roadways. STOP! "Turn Around Don't Drown."

- The roadbed may be washed out.
- You can lose control of your vehicle in only a few inches of water.
- Your car may float. Vehicles can be swept away by less than 2 feet of water.
- Do not drive around a barricade. Turn around and go another way!

Get to higher ground – Climb to safety!

- Get out of low areas that may be subject to flooding.
- Avoid already-flooded areas and do not attempt to cross flowing water.
- Stay away from power lines and electrical wires.

Evacuate immediately, if you think you are at risk or are advised to do so!

- Act quickly. Save yourself, not your belongings.
- Move to a safe area before access is cut off by rising water.
- Families should use only one vehicle to avoid getting separated and reduce traffic jams.
- Shut off water, gas, and electrical services before leaving.
- Secure your home: lock all doors and windows.
- If directed to a specific location, go there.

Never try to walk or swim through flowing water.

- If flowing water is above your ankles, STOP! Turn around and go another way.
- If it is moving swiftly, water 6 inches deep can knock you off your feet.
- Be aware that people have been swept away wading through flood waters.
- NEVER allow children to play around high water, storm drains, creeks, or rivers.

Shut off the electricity at the circuit breakers.

If someone falls in or is trapped in flood water:

- Do not go after the victim!
- Use a floatation device. If possible throw the victim something to help them float, such as a spare tire, large ball, or foam ice chest.
- Call 911. Call for assistance and give the correct location information.

AFTER A FLOOD

Wait until it is safe to return.

- Monitor NOAA Weather Radio or local television and radio stations.
- Do not return to flooded areas until authorities indicate it is safe to do so.
- Do not visit disaster areas following a flood. Your presence may hamper urgent emergency response and rescue operations.

Travel with care.

- Follow recommended routes. DO NOT sightsee.
- Watch for washed out roads, earth slides, and downed trees or power lines.
- Stay away from downed power lines.

If a building was flooded, check for safety before entering.

- Do not enter a building if it is still flooded or surrounded by floodwater.
- Check for structural damage. Inspect foundations for cracks or other damage.
- Turn off any outside gas lines at the meter tank.
- Do not enter a building that has flooded until local building officials have inspected it for safety.

Use extreme caution when entering buildings.

- Wear sturdy shoes. The most common injury following a disaster is cut feet.
- Use ONLY battery-powered lighting. Flammable material may be present.
- Look for fire hazards (such as damaged gas lines, flooded electrical circuits, or submerged furnaces).
- Check for gas leaks. If you smell gas or hear a blowing or hissing noise, open a window and quickly leave the building. If possible turn off the gas at the outside main valve. Call the gas company.
- Report broken utility lines to appropriate authorities.
- Check for electrical system damage (sparks, broken or frayed wires, or the smell of burning insulation). Turn off the electricity at the main circuit breaker if you can reach it without stepping in water.
- Examine walls, floors, doors, windows, and ceilings for risk of collapsing.
- Watch out for animals that might have entered with the floodwaters.

- Let the building air out to remove foul odors or escaping gas.

Take pictures of the damage, both of the building and its contents, for insurance claims.

Get professional help.

- Seek necessary medical care. Do not neglect minor wounds or illnesses.
- Food, clothing, shelter, and first aid are available from the American Red Cross.
- If the gas has been turned off for any reason, it must be turned back on by a professional.
- Have an electrician check the electrical system and appliances.
- Wells should be pumped out and the water tested for purity before drinking.

Your home is no longer a safe place.

- Throw away medicine, food, or water that had contact with floodwaters (including canned goods).
- If water is of questionable purity, boil drinking water for 10 minutes.
- Restrict children from playing in flooded areas.
- Keep windows and doors open for ventilation.
- Pump out flooded basements gradually (removing about 1/3 of the water volume each day) to avoid structural damage.
- Keep the power off until an electrician has inspected the system for safety. All electrical equipment should be checked and dried before being returned to service.
- Clean and disinfect everything that got wet.
- Service damaged sewage systems as soon as possible.

When making repairs, protect your property from future flood damage.

- Follow local building codes.
- Use flood-resistant materials and techniques.
- Elevate electrical components above the potential flood height.
- Elevate utilities (washer, dryer, furnace, and water heater) above the level of anticipated flooding.
- Consider elevation of the entire structure.
- Install a backflow valve in the sewer system.

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7. Drawbridges

- (a) Volusia County has seven drawbridges, five on the Halifax River and two on the St. Johns River. Three of these bridges are controlled by Volusia County (Highbridge, Mainstreet, and Silver Beach/Orange Avenue) and three are controlled by the State (Astor, N. Bridge, and Whitehair).
- (b) During the latter stages of a hurricane evacuation, it will become necessary to "lockdown" the lifting spans of the drawbridges (when winds reach 39 MPH sustained). This action, taken by the agency responsible for bridge tending operations in coordination with the United States Coast Guard, will protect the moving parts of the bridge during the anticipated strong winds. Upon completion of "lockdown" marine traffic will not be able to proceed through that bridge. The authority to regulate marine traffic as supported by drawbridge operations rests with the U.S. Coast Guard and must be further coordinated with agencies represented within the VCEOC in accordance with the FDOT District 5 Movable Bridge Emergency Operation Plan. 395.1055 Rules and enforcement.—

(1) The agency shall adopt rules pursuant to ss. [120.536\(1\)](#) and [120.54](#) to implement the provisions of this part, which shall include reasonable and fair minimum standards for ensuring that:

(a) Sufficient numbers and qualified types of personnel and occupational disciplines are on duty and available at all times to provide necessary and adequate patient care and safety.

(b) Infection control, housekeeping, sanitary conditions, and medical record procedures that will adequately protect patient care and safety are established and implemented.

(c) A comprehensive emergency management plan is prepared and updated annually. Such standards must be included in the rules adopted by the agency after consulting with the Division of Emergency Management. At a minimum, the rules must provide for plan components that address emergency evacuation transportation; adequate sheltering arrangements; postdisaster activities, including emergency power, food, and water; postdisaster transportation; supplies; staffing; emergency equipment; individual identification of residents and transfer of records, and responding to family inquiries. The comprehensive emergency management plan is subject to review and approval by the local emergency management agency. During its review, the local emergency management agency shall ensure that the following agencies, at a minimum, are given the opportunity to review the plan: the Department of Elderly Affairs, the Department of Health, the Agency for Health Care Administration, and the Division of Emergency Management. Also, appropriate volunteer organizations must be given the opportunity to review the plan. The local emergency management agency shall complete its review within 60 days and either approve the plan or advise the facility of necessary revisions.

(d) Licensed facilities are established, organized, and operated consistent with established standards and rules.

(e) Licensed facility beds conform to minimum space, equipment, and furnishings standards as specified by the department.

(f) All hospitals submit such data as necessary to conduct certificate-of-need reviews required under part I of chapter 408. Such data shall include, but shall not be limited to, patient origin data, hospital utilization data, type of service reporting, and facility staffing data. The agency may not collect data that identifies or could disclose the identity of individual patients. The agency shall utilize existing uniform statewide data sources when available and shall minimize reporting costs to hospitals.

(g) Each hospital has a quality improvement program designed according to standards established by their current accrediting organization. This program will enhance quality of care and emphasize quality patient outcomes, corrective action for problems, governing board review, and reporting to the agency of standardized data elements necessary to analyze quality of care outcomes. The agency shall use existing data, when available, and shall not duplicate the efforts of other state agencies in order to obtain such data.

400.967 Rules and classification of deficiencies.—

(1) It is the intent of the Legislature that rules adopted and enforced under this part and part II of chapter 408 include criteria by which a reasonable and consistent quality of resident care may be ensured, the results of such resident care can be demonstrated, and safe and sanitary facilities can be provided.

(2) Pursuant to the intention of the Legislature, the agency, in consultation with the Agency for Persons with Disabilities and the Department of Elderly Affairs, shall adopt and enforce rules to administer this part and part II of chapter 408, which shall include reasonable and fair criteria governing:

(a) The location and construction of the facility; including fire and life safety, plumbing, heating, cooling, lighting, ventilation, and other housing conditions that ensure the health, safety, and comfort of residents. The agency shall establish standards for facilities and equipment to increase the extent to which new facilities and a new wing or floor added to an existing facility after July 1, 2000, are structurally capable of serving as shelters only for residents, staff, and families of residents and staff, and equipped to be self-supporting during and immediately following disasters. The agency shall update or revise the criteria as the need arises. All facilities must comply with those lifesafety code requirements and building code standards applicable at the time of approval of their construction plans. The agency may require alterations to a building if it determines that an existing condition constitutes a distinct hazard to life, health, or safety. The agency shall adopt fair and reasonable rules setting forth conditions under which existing facilities undergoing additions, alterations, conversions, renovations, or repairs are required to comply with the most recent updated or revised standards.

(b) The number and qualifications of all personnel, including management, medical nursing, and other personnel, having responsibility for any part of the care given to residents.

(c) All sanitary conditions within the facility and its surroundings, including water supply, sewage disposal, food handling, and general hygiene, which will ensure the health and comfort of residents.

(d) The equipment essential to the health and welfare of the residents.

(e) A uniform accounting system.

(f) The care, treatment, and maintenance of residents and measurement of the quality and adequacy thereof.

(g) The preparation and annual update of a comprehensive emergency management plan. The agency shall adopt rules establishing minimum criteria for the plan after consultation with the Division of Emergency Management. At a minimum, the rules must provide for plan components that address emergency evacuation transportation; adequate sheltering arrangements; postdisaster activities, including emergency power, food, and water; postdisaster transportation; supplies; staffing; emergency

equipment; individual identification of residents and transfer of records; and responding to family inquiries. The comprehensive emergency management plan is subject to review and approval by the local emergency management agency. During its review, the local emergency management agency shall ensure that the following agencies, at a minimum, are given the opportunity to review the plan: the Department of Elderly Affairs, the Agency for Persons with Disabilities, the Agency for Health Care Administration, and the Division of Emergency Management. Also, appropriate volunteer organizations must be given the opportunity to review the plan. The local emergency management agency shall complete its review within 60 days and either approve the plan or advise the facility of necessary revisions.

(h) The use of restraint and seclusion. Such rules must be consistent with recognized best practices; prohibit inherently dangerous restraint or seclusion procedures; establish limitations on the use and duration of restraint and seclusion; establish measures to ensure the safety of clients and staff during an incident of restraint or seclusion; establish procedures for staff to follow before, during, and after incidents of restraint or seclusion, including individualized plans for the use of restraints or seclusion in emergency situations; establish professional qualifications of and training for staff who may order or be engaged in the use of restraint or seclusion; establish requirements for facility data collection and reporting relating to the use of restraint and seclusion; and establish procedures relating to the documentation of the use of restraint or seclusion in the client's facility or program record.

(3) The agency shall adopt rules to provide that, when the criteria established under this part and part II of chapter 408 are not met, such deficiencies shall be classified according to the nature of the deficiency. The agency shall indicate the classification on the face of the notice of deficiencies as follows:

(a) Class I deficiencies are those which the agency determines present an imminent danger to the residents or guests of the facility or a substantial probability that death or serious physical harm would result therefrom. The condition or practice constituting a class I violation must be abated or eliminated immediately, unless a fixed period of time, as determined by the agency, is required for correction. A class I deficiency is subject to a civil penalty in an amount not less than \$5,000 and not exceeding \$10,000 for each deficiency. A fine may be levied notwithstanding the correction of the deficiency.

(b) Class II deficiencies are those which the agency determines have a direct or immediate relationship to the health, safety, or security of the facility residents, other than class I deficiencies. A class II deficiency is subject to a civil penalty in an amount not less than \$1,000 and not exceeding \$5,000 for each deficiency. A citation for a class II deficiency shall specify the time within which the deficiency must be corrected. If a class II deficiency is corrected within the time specified, no civil penalty shall be imposed, unless it is a repeated offense.

(c) Class III deficiencies are those which the agency determines to have an indirect or potential relationship to the health, safety, or security of the facility residents, other than class I or class II deficiencies. A class III deficiency is subject to a civil penalty of not less than \$500 and not exceeding \$1,000 for each deficiency. A citation for a class III deficiency shall specify the time within which the deficiency must be corrected. If a class III deficiency is corrected within the time specified, no civil penalty shall be imposed, unless it is a repeated offense.

(4) The agency shall approve or disapprove the plans and specifications within 60 days after receipt of the final plans and specifications. The agency may be granted one 15-day extension for the review period, if the secretary of the agency so approves. If the agency fails to act within the specified time, it is deemed to have approved the plans and specifications. When the agency disapproves plans and

specifications, it must set forth in writing the reasons for disapproval. Conferences and consultations may be provided as necessary.

(5) The agency may charge an initial fee of \$2,000 for review of plans and construction on all projects, no part of which is refundable. The agency may also collect a fee, not to exceed 1 percent of the estimated construction cost or the actual cost of review, whichever is less, for the portion of the review which encompasses initial review through the initial revised construction document review. The agency may collect its actual costs on all subsequent portions of the review and construction inspections. Initial fee payment must accompany the initial submission of plans and specifications. Any subsequent payment that is due is payable upon receipt of the invoice from the agency. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all money received by the agency under this section shall be deemed to be trust funds, to be held and applied solely for the operations required under this section.
