Summer BreakSpot is looking for meal sites for summer 2019, and your community needs YOU!

Summer BreakSpot, a federally funded program that fills the summer hunger gap, allows organizations to serve healthy meals to children in Florida while school is out. Sites can serve breakfast and/or lunch in Volusia County.

Volusia County's Community Assistance Division is seeking churches and nonprofits to participate in the program, which will run from **June 3 through August 9**. Summer BreakSpot provides meals and snacks to all children ages 18 and younger in areas where at least 50% of the children are eligible for free or reduced-price meals.

Approved sites will receive meals to serve to participating children. There is no cost to your organization!
