



Lyonia Preserve Trails



This preserve, named after the scrub plant Rusty Lyonia (*Lyonia ferruginea*), consists of 360 acres of restored Florida scrub. This habitat provides a home for scrub dependent species, including the threatened scrub jay and gopher tortoise.

- Blue Trail (2.4 MILES)
- Orange Trail (0.4 MILES)
- Red Trail (1.6 MILES)
