Scrub Oak Preserve Trail



Scrub Oak Preserve is an important piece in the wildlife corridor between Blue Spring State Park and the Lake Beresford area that is used by black bears. This preserve is also a successful scrub restoration site, providing habitat for the Florida Scrub Jay. The porous soil here provides an important aquifer recharge area for Blue Spring, winter home to a growing number of Florida manatee.
