County Operated Disposal Sites

Household garbage, yard waste, construction debris, appliances and tires are accepted for a nominal fee at the Tomoka Farms Road Landfill and the West Volusia Transfer Station. (Each waste type must be separated)

County residents may dispose of up to four regular passenger size tires free on Saturdays at either site.

Both locations also have a household hazardous waste drop-off sites and a paint exchange where residents may dispose of chemicals and trade used paints for new colors. Used motor oil can be deposited at the used oil recycling igloo available on site. (Not for commercial use)
