Notice of Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement Amendment between Volusia County and the City of Oak Hill

Volusia County and the City of Oak Hill are considering an amendment to the Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement (ISBA) to include additional properties. You are receiving this notice because you own property that is within the proposed ISBA expansion area. The map on the back of this flyer depicts the expansion area, depicted by grey dashed lines.

The ISBA addresses the provision of public services to properties within the service boundary area. The purpose of the agreement is to improve the efficiency of planning for, and delivery of, governmental services. The following are the primary elements of the agreement:

- The agreement addresses voluntary annexation of properties within the ISBA. Property owners may voluntarily petition for annexation regardless of contiguity to the city. Properties are not required to annex by this agreement.
- Delivery and funding of various public services such as: public safety, utilities, roadway maintenance, and stormwater maintenance.
- Coordination of transportation planning.
- Clarification of responsibilities related to environmental management, planning and development services and building permits.

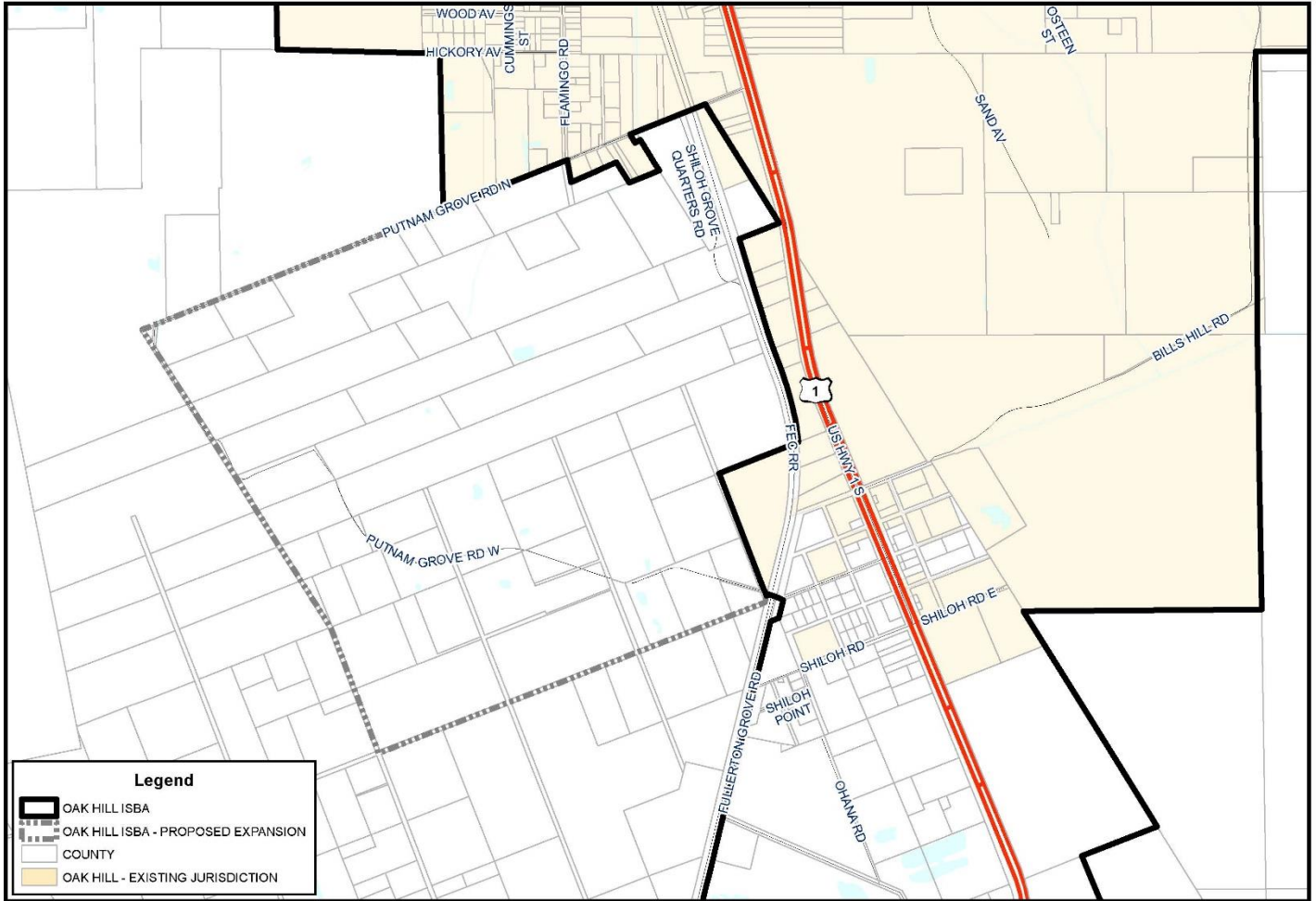
