

**THIRTEENTH DIRECTIVE ON EMERGENCY MEASURES**  
**TO BE IMPLEMENTED BY THE COUNTY OF VOLUSIA**  
**RESCINDING THE TWELFTH DIRECTIVE**

WHEREAS, The Governor's Executive Order No. 21-102, suspended the enforcement of the Twelfth Directive on May 3, 2021; and

WHEREAS, this Thirteenth Directive rescinds the Twelfth Directive.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, GEORGE RECKTENWALD, as County Manager for the County of Volusia, Florida, and pursuant to the authority vested in me under Section 46-143, Code of Ordinances, County of Volusia, Chapter 252, Florida Statutes, Chapter 20, Code of Ordinances, County of Volusia, as well as that certain County of Volusia Declaration of Local Emergency for Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), dated March 13, 2020, and subsequently extended, **I HEREBY ISSUE** this Thirteenth Directive on Emergency Measures:

- Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order No. 21-102, the Twelfth Directive on Emergency Measures to be Implemented by the County of Volusia, signed on February 2, 2021 and effective February 3, 2021, is hereby rescinded and no longer in effect.

This Thirteenth Directive shall be effective immediately.
