

## **Irma Cost Recovery Update #8**

When a Federal disaster is declared, FEMA can reimburse affected entities a percent of their costs. President Trump signed an Emergency Declaration for Hurricane Irma, which included Florida and Volusia County on September 10, 2017. This allowed FEMA to reimburse a percent of emergency costs including Emergency Protective Measures (Category B) and Debris Removal (Category A). The County has since been approved for the remaining Categories C-G for permanent repairs.

Debris removal (Category A) includes the removal of debris as well as the debris monitoring company required by FEMA. For Hurricane Irma, the County had over 814,000 cubic yards of debris removed, reduced, mulched, and monitored for an estimated cost of \$14,613,248. After deducting the County's local match required of \$768,291, a total of \$13,844,957 is expected in reimbursements from the State. As of February 10, 2023, the County has received \$13,821,659 in reimbursements from FEMA and the State for debris removal (**99.8% reimbursed**). Normally, maintenance of HOA and private roads are the responsibility of the property owners. However, the County submitted documentation to FEMA that was judged to qualify the County for FEMA reimbursement for removal of vegetative debris from HOAs and private roads. The total cost of HOA and private road debris removal is estimated to be \$1,205,510, and is included in the total estimated cost previously stated.

Emergency protective measures (Category B) includes pre-storm preparations to secure locations, hand out sandbags, stage essential personnel and equipment, evacuate patients from hospitals and other facilities, and prepare evacuation shelters as well as other pre-storm activities. It also includes activities during the storm including staffing the Emergency Operations Center with extra personnel to answer phones, personnel to work in shelters, extra sheriff patrols, and fire services as well as other services. Immediately after the storm, emergency protective services include clearing roads and walkways of downed powerlines and trees. As of February 10, 2023, excluding the cost of temporary locations for the former occupants of 250 North Beach Street and the cost of reimbursing the school board for sheltering expenses, the County had estimated costs of \$2,801,961 in Emergency Protective Measures. The County estimates a total of \$2,858,518 in additional costs for Emergency Protective Measures for temporary locations for the former occupants of 250 North Beach Street that will be accounted for in the Hurricane Irma fund (note: these leases continue to be paid by the home department's fund going forward). In addition, the school board had FEMA eligible passthrough costs of \$482,931 for sheltering operations during Hurricane Irma. Emergency protective measures in total are estimated to cost \$6,143,410.

Pursuant to the final settlement approved by the County Council, the County has received \$3,829,726 in insurance proceeds for activities reported under emergency protective measures. After reducing for insurance proceeds as well as county match and other adjustments totaling \$322,120, \$1,991,564 in emergency costs remain for FEMA and State reimbursement. As of February 10, 2023, the County has received \$1,914,871 in reimbursements from FEMA and the State for emergency protective measures (**96.1% reimbursed**).

Roads and Bridges (Category C) includes work to repair surfaces, bases, shoulders, ditches, and drainage structures. For Hurricane Irma, the County has estimated repair costs of \$683,832. After reducing for county match and other adjustments totaling \$34,579, \$639,253 in category C costs remain for FEMA and State reimbursement. As of February 10, 2023, the County has received \$572,026 in reimbursements from FEMA and the State for roads and bridges, with the remaining \$77,227 expected to be reimbursed at during the project close-out process.

Buildings and Equipment (Category E) includes damage to buildings and equipment as well as the equipment usage, cleaning and treatment of mold, and replacement of inventory destroyed or consumed for the disaster. As of February 10, 2023, the County has estimated repair and/or replacement costs of \$2,452,720 for Category E damages. After reducing for insurance proceeds, county match and other adjustments totaling \$1,122,537, \$1,330,183 in category E costs remain for FEMA and State reimbursement. As of February 10, 2023, the County has received \$485,008 in reimbursements from FEMA and the State for buildings and equipment. The balance owed of \$845,175 is primarily related to the mitigation work performed at the Daytona Beach City Island library, which was both completed and submitted for reimbursement during fiscal year 2022.

Utilities (Category F) includes damages to water treatment plants, power facilities, and communications. For Hurricane Irma, the County has estimated repair costs of \$47,705 for Category F damages. As of February 10, 2023, the County has received \$19,596 in reimbursements from FEMA and the State for utilities, which represents 100% reimbursement after considering County required match and proceeds paid from insurance.

Parks, Recreational Facilities, and Other (Category G) includes parks, beaches, and other items that do not fit into the other categories. For Hurricane Irma, the County has estimated repair costs of \$988,526. As of February 10, 2023, the County has received \$858,054 in reimbursements from FEMA and the State for parks, recreational facilities and other, which represents 100% reimbursement after considering County required match and proceeds paid from insurance.

The County has submitted Project Worksheets for actual and/or estimated costs to FEMA. The State coordinates with FEMA. FEMA and/or the State can approve, deny, or modify requests. Once approved, FEMA generally reimburses up to 75% of the approved amount. The State will reimburse half of the remaining amount. The County is responsible for the remainder. FEMA has a program that allows for a slightly higher reimbursement for Category A costs depending on when the work was completed. In addition, the President approved Category B as 100% for the first 30 days of the Hurricane Irma incident period. The Governor requested and FEMA subsequently approved an increase FEMA's share to 90% on all projects except the projects already at a higher share.

As of February 10, 2023, the County has total estimated costs of \$25,579,961 including \$650,520 in direct administrative costs. Pursuant to the final settlement approved by the County Council, the County has received \$7,606,884 in insurance proceeds related to Hurricane Irma, of which \$4,676,911 has been applied as a deduction to FEMA eligible costs, with \$2,929,973 either applied to non-FEMA eligible costs or remaining available in the Hurricane Irma fund. The County has received \$17,671,214 from FEMA and the State as of February 10, 2023. If all remaining costs submitted to FEMA are approved, the County should receive an additional \$1,681,329 from FEMA and the State for a total of 19,221,721. The County's match requirement, including small project variances, is \$1,681,329.
