Dorian Cost Recovery Update #4

When a Federal disaster is declared, FEMA can reimburse affected entities a percent of their costs. President Trump signed an Emergency Declaration for Hurricane Dorian, which included Florida and Volusia County on October 21, 2019. This allowed FEMA to reimburse a percent of emergency costs including Emergency Protective Measures (Category B) and Debris Removal (Category A) as well as Categories C-G for permanent repairs.

Debris removal (Category A) includes the removal of debris. For Hurricane Dorian, the County utilized staff to have debris removed for an estimated cost of \$14,122. As of March 9, 2024, the County has received all expected reimbursements from FEMA and the State for debris removal, totaling \$12,356.

Emergency protective measures (Category B) includes pre-storm preparations to secure locations, hand out sandbags, stage essential personnel and equipment, evacuate patients from hospitals and other facilities, and prepare evacuation shelters as well as other pre-storm activities. It also includes activities during the storm including staffing the Emergency Operations Center with extra personnel to answer phones, personnel to work in shelters, extra sheriff patrols, and fire services as well as other services. Immediately after the storm, emergency protective services include clearing roads and walkways of downed powerlines and trees. As of March 9, 2024, the County had estimated costs of \$832,354 in Emergency Protective Measures. In addition, the school board has reported estimated costs of \$158,232 for sheltering operations during Hurricane Dorian. Emergency protective measures in total are estimated to cost \$990,586. As of March 9, 2024, the County has received \$466,447 in reimbursements from FEMA and the State for emergency protective measures.

Buildings and Equipment (Category E) includes damage to buildings and equipment as well as the equipment usage, cleaning and treatment of mold, and replacement of inventory destroyed or consumed for the disaster. As of March 9, 2024, the County has estimated repair and/or replacement costs of \$24,675 for Category E damages. As of March 9, 2024, the County has received all expected reimbursements from FEMA and the State for buildings and equipment, totaling \$21,591.

Parks, Recreational Facilities, and Other (Category G) includes parks, beaches, and other items that do not fit into the other categories. As of March 9, 2024, the County has estimated repair costs of \$1,180,497, of which \$83,398 is completed as of March 9, 2024 and \$1,097,099 remains to be complete was of the same date. Only completed work is eligible for FEMA reimbursement. As of March 9, 2024, the County has received \$4,522 in reimbursements from FEMA and the State for parks, recreational facilities and other.

The County has submitted Project Worksheets for actual and/or estimated costs to FEMA. The State coordinates with FEMA. FEMA and/or the State can approve, deny, or modify requests. Once approved, FEMA generally reimburses up to 75% of the approved amount. The State will reimburse half of the remaining amount. As of March 9, 2024, the County has total estimated costs of \$2,212,130 including \$2,250 in grant management costs.

Approximately 50% of the total estimated costs, or \$1,097,099, is not yet reimbursable by the FEMA grant program, as construction is not yet completed. Of the remaining work to be completed, approximately \$959,962 will be payable by FEMA and the state, once it is completed, with the remaining \$137,137 composing the County's match requirement.

The balance of completed permanent work, debris removal, emergency protective measures and grant management costs totals \$1,115,031. The County has received \$504,917 from FEMA and the State as of March 9, 2024. If all remaining costs for work completed as of March 9, 2024 are approved, the County should receive an additional \$230,493 from FEMA and the State for a total of \$735,410 (on completed work). The County's match requirement for completed work, including expenses determined ineligible by FEMA, is \$379,621.
