


ORDER OF EVACUATION LIFTED

The Order of Evacuation issued by Volusia County on Wednesday, November 9, 2022, is hereby lifted as of 5 p.m. on Thursday, November 10, 2022, for all evacuees with a residence or accommodation west of State Highway A1A. The Order of Evacuation for evacuees with a residence or accommodation east of State Highway A1A remains in effect and will be lifted at 7 a.m. on Friday, November 11, 2022. Copy of Evacuation Order attached. Evacuees are encouraged to exercise caution in returning to beachside residences and ensure their home or accommodation is structurally sound and habitable. Additionally, returning evacuees are reminded that a curfew is currently in place until 7 a.m. Friday, November 11, 2022, east of the Intracoastal Waterway, and as result, should return from evacuation directly to their residence.

ORDER OF EVACUATION


Pursuant to the State of Emergency declared on November 7, 2022, by Governor Ron DeSantis in Executive Order Number 22-253, Declaration of Local Emergency for Subtropical Storm Nicole declared by Volusia County on November 7, 2022, and by the authority vested in me pursuant to section 252.38(3) (a) (5), Florida Statutes, and section 46-143, Code of Ordinances, County of Volusia, I hereby order a mandatory evacuation commencing at 10 a.m. on Wednesday, November 9, 2022, of all persons from areas within Volusia County as follows:

- 1) Any and all areas east of the intracoastal waterway;
- 2) Any and all manufactured and mobile home dwellers east of Interstate 95;
- 3) All low-lying areas and other areas prone to flooding; and
- 4) Any and all campsites and RV recreational vehicle parks.

Evacuees are encouraged to relocate with a family, friend or lodging establishment and must complete their evacuation by 4 p.m. on Wednesday, November 9, 2022. A limited number of shelters will be open during the event. Details on those shelters will be available at volusia.org/pin. County residents of manufactured and mobile homes and persons with special needs are strongly encouraged to evacuate. Each municipality is responsible for the enforcement and implementation of this order for their respective jurisdictions.
