3 4 5 6 7 8	AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE RELATING TO REGULATIONS DURING A STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY; PROVIDING FOR A CURFEW AND EXEMPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR THE TERRITORY EMBRACED; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
9 10	WHEREAS, the County Council of the County of Volusia, Florida, has declared a state
11	of local emergency;
12	WHEREAS, Florida Statutes, Chapter 252.38, provides authority for a political
13	subdivision such as Volusia County to declare a state of local emergency and to waive the
14	procedures and formalities otherwise required of political subdivisions by law pertaining to
15	taking whatever action is necessary to ensure the health, safety, and welfare of the
16	community; and
17	WHEREAS, the County Chair acting pursuant to County ordinance on behalf of the
18	County Council executed County Ordinance 2024-27 that previously authorized a curfew within
19	the incorporated and unincorporated areas of Volusia County; and
20	WHEREAS, Hurricane Milton has swept through the area and an additional curfew is
21	needed.
22 23	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF VOLUSIA COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:
24 25	SECTION I: An additional curfew within the incorporated and unincorporated areas of
26	Volusia County shall take effect on Thursday, October 10, 2024, at 9 p.m. and end on Friday,
27	October 11, 2024, at 5 a.m. EST (Eastern Standard Time). This curfew shall not apply to
28	regular members of the law enforcement bodies. Regular employees of businesses, industries,

or governmental entities, while traveling to and from their jobs, and all emergency workers are 1 exempt, provided they have identification if stopped by any law enforcement personnel. 2 SECTION III: All territory within the legal boundaries of Volusia County, Florida, 3 including all unincorporated and incorporated areas, shall be embraced by the provisions of 4 5 this Ordinance. **SECTION IV:** Any person who knowingly violates this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, 6 be subject to a fine not exceeding \$500.00, or imprisonment in the County jail for a period of 7 8 up to sixty (60) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. 9 **SECTION V:** This Emergency Ordinance shall take effect immediately unless rescinded 10 prior to that time.
